## Important Points

- **CalWIN migration training update**
  - Meeting with counties for proposed training dates/sites in progress
  - Changes to county staff migration training can still be made as needed
  - Course design maps and outlines in progress
  - Training Advisory Council (TAC) reviews in progress
  - Counties should have received all Sandbox licenses
  - CalSAWS will be distributing LMS accounts in the next few weeks
- **CalSAWS ILTs**
  - The Training Team will be creating instructor-led training (ILT) or training guides for CalSAWS maintenance
  - PowerPoint presentation on the ILTs the Project maintained for the C-IV System

    - Presentation to be provided to the committee after the meeting
  - CalSAWS is looking for input from the counties regarding their training material needs
    - What the maintenance and operations look like moving forward
