CA-232611 - Update the duplicate aid check for Medi-Cal was created to address multiple issues related to the duplicate aid check. A release date has not been determined.

County Action

For individuals/cases that are failing EDBC due to Reason of "Gets Duplicate Aid", the worker should:

- Determine if duplicate aid actually exists by conducting a Search in CalSAWS.
 - If duplicate aid exists, then the failed EDBC for Gets Duplicate Aid is correct and counties should take action on the case as appropriate.
 - o If duplicate aid does not exist, the worker should review the OPA Detail page.
 - ✓ If there are entries for State and/or County on the OPA Detail page, the worker should edit the record to remove those entries.
 - ✓ Once entries are removed, re-run EDBC.
- If the EDBC still results in a negative action, evaluate for other possible EDBC mismatch reasons, and take action on the case as appropriate.

Mandatory Verifications

CIT 0239-21 - Mandatory Verifications (attached) was issued explaining how past due mandatory verifications are processed in CalSAWS. For counties who opted in, a monthly EDBC batch sweep applies a negative action when the mandatory verifications are in an overdue status. In addition to the EDBC batch sweep, if there is an overdue mandatory verification for the program and a user runs EDBC online, the system applies the mandatory verification logic. Also, because the logic to discontinue for past due verifications is handled within the EDBC logic, if batch EDBC runs the program for any other reason, the discontinuance logic for the overdue verification is applied by the system even if the county did not opt in to the monthly batch.

Note: The Public Health Emergency (PHE) protections are still in place and the system will not take negative action in any batch EDBC for Medi-Cal cases (except for some allowable reasons). Cases ran by batch which result in a negative action for a non-allowable reason are saved as a Read-Only EDBC which prevents the negative action from being applied to the MC program.

CIT 0239-21 reported that MAGI <u>and MAGI/Non-MAGI mixed</u> cases are not impacted by the EDBC batch sweep job. Clarification has been received that <u>all Non-MAGI individuals</u> are impacted, even those who are in a MAGI/Non-MAGI mixed case. Only MAGI individuals are not impacted by overdue mandatory verifications logic. CA-233655 - List of Medi-Cal individuals with overdue Mandatory MC Verifications has been created to obtain a list of Non-MAGI individuals with overdue verifications. There is not currently a release date for this SCR.

Mandatory verifications for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal are as follows:

- Income
- Liquid property
- Motor vehicles
- Personal property
- Real property
- Residence
- Transferred property

	County Action When reviewing cases with EDBC mismatch, the worker should do the following to prevent negative action due to past due mandatory verifications: Review case for any past due verification(s). If a past due mandatory verification is identified, update the applicable verification status to 'Verified'. Re-run EDBC. If the EDBC still results in a negative action, evaluate for other possible EDBC mismatch reasons, and take action on the case as appropriate. Note: Past due verifications on the MC 355 List Page are not considered by the system when applying the overdue mandatory verifications logic.
