C re h (C tc C D A	alSAWS has a 'Gets Duplicate Aid' rule that checks if an individual is already seciving MC or cash-based Medi-Cal. Currently the 'Gets Duplicate Aid' rule is ard coded to check specifically for Los Angeles County Other Program Assistance DPA) records and it immediately fails MC for 'Gets Duplicate Aid' if the OPA is set another California county without doing an aid code comparison. Since this amparison doesn't happen, Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) may fail for 'Gets uplicate Aid' if there is an OPA record set to any California county other than Los ngeles, including when the OPA is for SSI or SSI/SSP.  The C-IV did not have 'Gets Duplicate Aid' logic, there may be old high-dated PA records for MC or cash-based MC that should be end dated. There may also be "other EDBC" with MC that will cause the MC EDBC budget to fail for 'Gets

Duplicate Aid'. The "other EDBC" with MC may be due to an Individual being

active on Non-MAGI, Non-MSP Medi-Cal Program and on at least one other Medi-Cal program block that is Non-MSP, or an Individual is active on a Medi-Cal Program with an MSP Aid code and being active on at least one other Medi-Cal program block that is MSP.

Additionally, a MC beneficiary may have had a failed budget for 'Gets Duplicate Aid' based on the old high-dated OPA record, due to the OPA LA county check or due to other MC EDBC reasons (explained above).

LA County may have old high-dated OPA records for MC or cash-based MC that did not fail a MC budget for 'Gets Duplicate Aid' that will now be considered in the MC aid code comparison and fail a budget for 'Gets Duplicate Aid'.

SCR CA-232611 - Update the duplicate aid check for Medi-Cal was created to address multiple issues related to the duplicate aid check. It is set for priority release with a release date of December 08, 2021.
