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Description:	<p>Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to provide CalSAWS counties with information regarding completion of the Citizenship Detail page when a Compact of Free Association (COFA) individual is eligible/applying for both Medi-Cal (MC) <u>and</u> Cash Assistance Program for Immigrants (CAPI).</p> <p>Background Based on the Consolidated Appropriations Act 2021, citizens from a COFA country residing in the United States, DC or US Territories are considered Qualifying Non-Citizens and are not subject to the 5-year bar. This allows the COFA individuals to get full scope Medi-Cal if they are otherwise eligible. The change in policy was effective 12/01/2020 for Medi-Cal. COFA individuals generally have immigration document types of I-94 and I-688B/I-766. These document types with their identified section codes are entered into the Citizenship Detail page. Updates made with CA-228190 in release 21.11 will allow COFA individuals to receive full-scope Medi-Cal.</p> <p>Additional Information Since data collection pages are shared by programs, entries from one program can affect another program. The Citizenship Detail page for a MC <u>and</u> CAPI individual where the CAPI individual's Document Type is PRUCOL should <u>not</u> be</p>
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	<p>changed, changing the Document Type to an I-94 or I-688B/I-766 will impact the individual's eligibility for CAPI. . A selection of PRUCOL is acceptable for Medi-Cal and will allow the customer to receive full scope Medi-Cal and CAPI benefits, as appropriate.</p> <p>County Action</p> <p>In cases where a Document Type of PRUCOL is used for a COFA individual receiving both MC and CAPI , it is necessary for the worker to manually update the Refugee/Alien Indicator code to '4' in MEDS. This will allow the customer to be tracked by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) as a COFA individual.</p> <p>If you have questions on this CIT, please reach out to the Primary Contact and cc your Regional Managers.</p>
