1 OVERVIEW

The purpose of SCR CA-50776 is to automate the creation of CalFresh (CF) Eligibility Non-Compliances based on Welfare To Work (WTW)/ Refugee Employment Program (REP) 'Sanction' statuses in order to eliminate the manual process of having the worker create CF Eligibility Non-Compliances for WTW and REP program sanctions.

1.1 Current Design

In CalSAWS, when a WTW program is updated to a status of 'Sanction', an automated task is created to have the worker manually add a CalFresh (CF) WTW Eligibility Non-Compliance.

1.2 Requests

SCR CA-50303 implemented automation for creating WTW/REP Eligibility Non-Compliances for the Cash programs based on program 'Sanction' statuses added through Employment Services WTW/REP program status page. The Committee has requested that similar automation be included for creating CF Eligibility Non-Compliances based on WTW/REP 'Sanction' statuses.

1.3 Overview of Recommendations

1. Update the WTW/REP Status Detail page to automatically create a CF WTW Eligibility Non-Compliance record based on the program 'Sanction' status record.
1. Update the CF EDBC Summary page to store and display data in a new EDBC section called "Sanctions and Penalties".
2. Update CF EDBC logic to populate the "Sanctions and Penalties" section of the CF EDBC Summary page based on CF WTW Eligibility Non-Compliances effective for the benefit period.
3. Add new batch job to create CF Eligibility Non-Compliance records based on 'Sanction' status records added by user.
4. Update Sanction Sync batch job to create CF Eligibility Non-Compliance records to 'sync' with 'Sanction' status records created by batch.
5. Update WTW Sanction Created batch sweep job to also trigger CF EDBC when a WTW type CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record is effective the month following the batch run month.
6. Add new Task Sweep batch job and Automated Action for CF WTW Eligibility Non-Compliances created for Two Parent HH with Child Under Age 6.
7. Update Task Sweep batch job that triggers the 'Welfare to Work: Sanction Ended – Update CalFresh Disqualification' task creation to include REP program and 'Good Cause' and 'Exempt' WTW/REP program statuses.
8. Update Automated Action detail page for 'Welfare to Work: CalFresh Disqualification Ending' and 'Welfare to Work: Sanction Ended-Update CalFresh Disqualification' automated actions.

1.4 Assumptions

1. Automation for the GR/GA Eligibility Non-Compliances will be addressed in a future effort through SCR CA-232977.
- ~~2. Fields not mentioned to be modified within the description of changes will retain their current functionality and logic.~~
2. When the WTW participant is no longer in 'Sanction' status or the CalFresh disqualification period ends (whichever comes first), the worker will be responsible for 'end dating' or removing the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record and run the EDBC to reinstate eligibility. The worker will be informed when the WTW sanction has ended (i.e. job number PB00A256) or when the CF disqualification period is ending (i.e. job number PB00A257).
3. Type 'WTW' will continue to be used for CF Eligibility Non-Compliance records created for REP program 'Sanction' individuals so there is no change to CF EDBC logic that imposes the role of 'FRE'.
4. NOAs that currently generate when CF program person has a CF Eligibility Non-Compliance for WTW will continue to generate with this SCR.
5. The "Sanctions and Penalties" section will not appear for CF EDBCs ran prior to the implementation of this SCR.
6. The maximum instance value for a CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record is '3'. If the instance count of CF program Eligibility Non-Compliances is greater than '3' for the CF participant, the instance will be set to '3' for each subsequent record.
7. CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record will not be created for WTW/REP 'Sanction' statuses with a reason of 'Sanction Cured', 'Sanction Denied', '2nd Instance', '3rd Instance', 'Failed to sign post 24 MTC Fed plan', 'Post WTW 24 MTC Failed to Sign Subsequent Fed Plan', 'Post WTW 24 MTC Fed Standards Not Met – Progress' or 'Post WTW 24 MTC Fed Standards Not Met – Participation'.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Update WTW Status Detail Page and the REP Status Detail Page

2.1.1 Overview

Update the WTW Status Detail page and the REP Status Detail page to automatically create CF 'WTW' Eligibility Non-Compliance record when 'Sanction' records are added, and no applicable CF work registration exemptions exist.

2.1.3 Description of Changes

1. Add logic to the Welfare to Work Status Detail page and the REP Status Detail page to create an WTW CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record for the participant when a status of 'Sanction' is set.
 - a. If a Work Registration status record of 'Exempt' exists with type 'CFWR', do not generate the WTW CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record with the exception of the following:
 - i. If there is only a high dated Work Registration status record of 'Exempt' with type 'CFWR' with a reason of 'Welfare to Work Participant' for the sanctioned CW/CF

participant, then the system logic should create a CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record.

- b. The CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record should align with the same values as the Cash Eligibility Non-Compliance record except for the reason codes (see Recommendation 3) and 'Program' field which will hold the value of 'CalFresh'.
 - i. Add a row to the 'Eligibility Non-Compliance Records to Be Created' table on the confirmation page that contains these same values.

Note: This record will only be created if there is not an existing record with the same type, reason and instance with overlapping dates.

- 2. To set the 'Instance' number, add logic to count the number of CF program Eligibility Non-Compliances that were entered for the CF participant. For example, if the CF participant had one existing CF Eligibility Non-Compliance with type 'IPV' which is set to Instance # 1, the WTW CF Eligibility Non-Compliance added by Online or Batch would be set to Instance # 2.
- 3. Add the following mapping logic that will determine the CF WTW Type Eligibility Non-Compliance reasons (CT365) to use with the equivalent WTW/REP Sanction Status Reasons as shown in the table below:

When processing the EDBC for the CalFresh program, CalSAWS will store and display the sanctioned WTW/REP program individuals in the CF EDBC Summary page.

2.1.3 Description of Changes

1. Update the CF EDBC Summary page to store and display the sanctioned (WTW/REP) individuals in a new “Sanctions and Penalties” section which will show the following:
 - a. Name – This will display the name of the individual who has the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance (WTW).
 - i. The Name will wrap to the next line if needed
 - b. Type – This field will display the type of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance (WTW).

- i. The type 'WTW' will be used for both WTW and REP sanctioned individuals.
 - c. Reason/Instance – This field will display the reason for which the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance has been imposed and CF Non-Compliance instance number.
 - i. The Reason will wrap to the next line if needed. The instance number will be concatenated to the reason.
 - d. Begin Date – This field will map to the effective begin date of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance (WTW).
 - e. End Date - This field will map to the effective end date of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance (WTW). This field will display as blank when end date is high dated.
 - f. The section will be displayed below the “Work Eligibility” section in the CF EDBC summary page.
2. Update EDBC PERS child database table that will store data for (WTW/REP) sanctioned individuals for the data listed 2.2.2 item 1.

- The 'Sanctions and Penalties' section will only display if there is only a valid CF Eligibility Non-Compliance for WTW effective for the benefit month.

2.2 Update CF EDBC to use the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance to populate the “Sanction and Penalties” section of the CF EDBC Summary Page.

2.2.1 Overview

The CF EDBC logic will be updated to use the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record effective for the benefit month to populate the new “Sanctions and Penalties” section of the CF EDBC Summary page.

2.2.2 Description of Changes

1. Update the CF EDBC logic to populate the "Sanction and Penalties" section of the CF EDBC Summary page based on the following data elements:
 - i. The Name will be the same as the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance participant name.
 - ii. The Type will be the same as the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance type. **Note:** 'WTW' type will be used for both WTW and REP sanctioned individuals.
 - iii. The Reason and Instance will be the same as the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance reason and instance.
 - iv. Begin Date - The begin date will be the effective begin date of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance.
 - v. End Date – The End Date will be the effective end date of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance.

2.3 Create New Batch Job WTW CalFresh Eligibility Non-Compliance Record

2.3.1 Overview

Create a new daily batch job to find WTW/REP sanction records added by user, check for CF exemptions, and create a CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record if no exemptions exist.

2.3.2 Description of Change

1. Create a new batch job to find WTW/REP records where 'Sanction' status was added by the user since the last batch run date and perform the following:
 - a) Check if any of the following CF exemptions apply to the sanctioned CF participant:
 1. Sanctioned CF participant is under the age of 16.
 2. Sanctioned CF participant is 60 years of age or older.
 3. Sanctioned CF Participant is disabled or incapacitated.

4. Sanctioned CF Participant in a single parent CF HH who is either the biological parent or has parental control of a child under the age of 6 years.
5. Sanctioned CF Participant is currently receiving unemployment income.
6. Sanctioned CF Participant has a living arrangement of Drug and Alcohol Rehabilitation.
7. Sanctioned CF Participant is working for 30 or more hours weekly.
8. Sanctioned CF Participant is attending school or training program for at least half time.

b) If no exemptions above are found, create a CF Eligibility Non-Compliance Record with the following values:

1. Set the 'Program' value to 'CalFresh'
2. Set the 'Type' to 'WTW' (For both WTW/REP Sanctions)
3. Set the 'Reason' to:

4. Set Begin Date of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance Record to the 1st of the 'Effective Month' of the Sanction status similar to the Online logic setting the begin date for the Cash Eligibility Non-Compliance WTW/REP type record (observing the 10 day notice).

5. Set the Instance Number to the number of CF Eligibility Non-Compliances entered for the CF participant. To set the 'Instance' number, add logic to count the number of CF program Eligibility Non-Compliances that were entered for the CF participant (Note: Eligibility Non-Compliance Type and Reason do not matter). For example, if the CF participant had one existing CF Eligibility Non-

Compliance with type 'Voluntary Quit/Striker' which is set to Instance #1, the WTW CF Eligibility Non-Compliance added by Batch would be set to Instance # 2.

Note: This record will only be created if there is not an existing record with the same type, reason and instance with overlapping dates.

- c) If a CF exemption is found, a journal entry will be created with the following values:
1. Category – All
 2. Type – Narrative
 3. Initiated By – System
 4. Short Description – CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record was not created due to a CalFresh exemption.
 5. Long Description - CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record was not created for {CF Participant Name} for the following CF exemption: {CF Exemption Description}

2.4 Enhance Sanction Sync Batch Job - PB00S934

2.4.1 Overview

Currently the 'Sanction Sync Batch Job' creates a new Cash Eligibility Non-Compliance record if there exists a WTW/REP program sanction status record created by batch since the last successful batch run date that is not being cured/denied and does not have a matching Eligibility Non-Compliance record.

Update PB00S934 batch job to create CF Eligibility Non-Compliance records to 'sync' with 'Sanction' status records. New CF records will meet the existing batch jobs Cash Program Eligibility Non-Compliance creation criteria in addition to the requirements below.

2.4.2 Description of Change

1. Modify PB00S934 to:

- ~~a. Check for a high dated work registration 'Exempt' status record with type 'CFWR'. If any record exists do not generate the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record~~
 - ~~i. Exception: Create record if there exists only one high dated 'CFWR' type record, in the 'Exempt' status with a reason of 'Welfare to Work Participant'. (No other high dated 'CFWR' type record, in the 'Exempt' status exists)~~
- a. Check if any of the following CF exemptions apply to the sanctioned CF participant:
 1. Sanctioned CF participant is under the age of 16.
 2. Sanctioned CF participant is 60 years of age or older.
 3. Sanctioned CF Participant is disabled or incapacitated.
 4. Sanctioned CF Participant in a single parent CF HH who is either the biological parent or has parental control of a child under the age of 6 years.
 5. Sanctioned CF Participant is currently receiving unemployment income.
 6. Sanctioned CF Participant has a living arrangement of Drug and Alcohol Rehabilitation.
 7. Sanctioned CF Participant is working for 30 or more hours weekly.
 8. Sanctioned CF Participant is attending school or training program for at least half time.

b. If no exemptions above are found, create a CF Eligibility Non-Compliance Record with the following values:

1. Set the 'Program' value to 'CalFresh'
2. Set the 'Type' to 'WTW' (For both WTW/REP Sanctions)
3. Set the 'Reason' to:

4. Set Begin Date of the CF Eligibility Non-Compliance Record to the 1st of the 'Effective Month' of the Sanction status similar to the Online logic setting the begin date for the Cash Eligibility Non-Compliance WTW/REP type record (observing the 10 day notice).

~~Set the Begin Date to the same begin date as the Cash Eligibility Non-Compliance record.~~

5. Set the Instance Number to the number of CF Eligibility Non-Compliances entered for the CF participant. To set the 'Instance' number, add logic to count the number of CF program Eligibility Non-Compliances that were entered for the CF participant (Note: Eligibility Non-Compliance Type and Reason do not matter). For example, if the CF participant had one existing CF Eligibility Non-Compliance with type 'Voluntary Quit/Striker' which is set to Instance #1, the WTW CF Eligibility Non-Compliance added by Batch would be set to Instance # 2. ~~(See Online recommendation for setting instance).~~

2.5 Enhance WTW Sanction Created Batch - PB00E179

Currently this batch job triggers CalWORKs/RCA EDBC when a WTW/REP type Eligibility Non-Compliance record is effective the month following the batch run month.

Update batch sweep job PB00E179 to also trigger CF EDBC when a WTW type CF Eligibility Non-Compliance record is effective the month following the batch run month.

2.5.2 Description of Change

1. Modify PB00E179 trigger logic to trigger CF EDBC for the come-up month:
 - a. CF persons are active the month following the batch run month.
 - b. There is an Eligibility Non-Compliance record with a Program value of 'CalFresh' and a Type of 'WTW' that is active the month following the batch run month and associated to the CF person.

2.6 New Task Sweep Batch Job and Automated Action – Check CF WTW Eligibility Non-Compliance For Two Parent HH with Child Under Age 6

2.6.1 Overview

Create a new Batch Task Sweep job to generate task for the worker to review the CF WTW Eligibility Non-Compliance records created for sanctioned WTW/REP participant(s) in a two parent CF HH where the sanctioned WTW/REP participant(s) is either the biological parent or has parental control of a child under the age of 6 years.

Create new Automated Action to be used by new task sweep batch job.

2.6.2 Description of Change

1. Create a new Batch Task Sweep Job to generate automated action (see recommendation 2 below) based on the following criteria since the last successful batch run date:
 - a) WTW/REP participant is either the biological parent or has parental control of a child under the age of 6 years in a two parent CF HH.
 - b) One or both parent WTW/REP participants have a high dated WTW or REP program status of 'Sanction'.
 - c) One or both parent WTW/REP participants have a high dated CF program Eligibility Non-Compliance record with type of 'WTW'.
2. Create the following Automated Action that will be triggered when the criteria from the Batch Task Sweep defined in recommendation 1 above is met:
 - a) Action Information:
 - **Name:** WTW/REP Program: Sanction Added For Two Parent CF HH -Review CF Disqualification
 - **Type:** Create Task
 - **Status:** Inactive
 - **Program(s):** CF, WT, RE
 - **Run Date:** Daily (Mon-Sat)
 - **Source:** Batch
 - **Scenario:** A Sanction has been added for a WTW/REP participant(s) in a two parent CF HH where the WTW/REP participant(s) is a biological parent or has parental control of a child under the age of 6 years. Take appropriate action.
 - b) Task Information:
 - **Task Type:** BLANK
 - **Task Sub-Type:** BLANK
 - **Due Date:** Default Due Date
 - **Default Due Date:** 1 day
 - **Initial Assignment:** Default Assignment
 - **Default Assignment:** Current Program Worker

3. Confirm that Non-Compliance records are not added for any of the cases.
4. Run EDBC online and confirm the Sanctions do not display for any of the cases.
5. Repeat the above scenarios for RCA, CF, and REP.
6. Create a case with CW, WTW, and REP. Add the Sanctions and confirm the Non-Compliance records are created.
