(Including any step-by-step instructions)	CalSAWS is integrating the CalSAWS login credentials with Amazon Web Services Single Sign-On (AWS SSO) to simplify the login experience and improve our security posture.
	Background
	Currently, users have separate AWS credentials and email multi-factor authentication (MFA) to sign-in and access CalSAWS AWS accounts for applications such as AppStream, Analytics Resources, and Conversion Environments.
	Going forward, the integration will require users to enter their CalSAWS login credentials along with email MFA to access CalSAWS AWS.
	Users logging into CalSAWS AWS accounts will be required to sign-in with their CalSAWS login credentials starting on <u>01/29/2022</u> at 5:00 AM.

The CalSAWS AWS URL will not change. User permissions within CalSAWS AWS will not change and will still be managed within CalSAWS AWS.

Users who already have a CalSAWS login credentials account <u>will now use their</u> <u>existing username</u>, <u>password</u>, <u>and MFA</u> to access CalSAWS AWS.

Users who DO NOT currently have a CalSAWS login credentials account will have one created for them the **Wednesday 1/26/2022** prior to migration. These users will receive an email with instructions and a link to complete account setup including password creation.






Once the change has been implemented, CalSAWS AWS users will be prompted to enter CalSAWS login credentials and accept the login terms on the CalSAWS login page.

The URL to reach CalSAWS AWS accounts will not change






After entering username and password, users will have a one-time password sent to their email.




Upon receiving this code, the user will enter the one-time password on the following screen.




Once MFA has been verified, you will be able to access AWS.

**For AppStream users**, once inside the AppStream, you will be asked for your CalSAWS login credentials to access a CalSAWS application.


