## Change Management Impacts

Engagement with the LA County Imaging Change Network will be extended, with an additional monthly Imaging Change Network Champion (CNC) meeting to be scheduled in April. Staff identified as Imaging CNCs will receive an updated meeting invitation.

The Imaging Change Management Team will create and distribute additional change communications to remain engaged with LA County through the new golive date.

## Training Impacts

The Imaging curriculum remains available in the CalSAWS Learning Management System (LMS). The deadline to complete Imaging training has been extended from Friday, March 11, 2022, to Friday, March 31, 2022, for DPSS and Monday, April 18, 2022, for DCFS.

LA County staff who have not yet started or completed their assigned Imaging curriculum are strongly encouraged to do so to ensure that all staff are fully trained before the new go-live date.

Weekly Imaging training completion reports will continue to be generated each Friday through April 22, 2022.

## **Implementation Impacts**
