When the following programs are granted for a pregnant or 365-day postpartum individual, the System keeps the MC program block open and grants them aid code 76 concurrently with the other program that includes full scope Medi-Cal:

- CalWORKs
- Foster Care
- Kin-GAP
- Adoption Assistance

The following are the allowable discontinuance reasons that are affected:

- Gets CW
- Gets FC
- Gets KG
- Gets AAP

All other allowable reasons correctly allow the person to fail and not be tested for postpartum.

For example, if an individual is receiving MC and is approved for CW, an aid code 76 is being established instead of the MC program being discontinued.

Defect CA-241990 was created to fix this and is scheduled for a 22.03 priority release. Until the Defect is released, when a worker encounters this issue and determines that the postpartum aid code should not apply, an override can be completed to fail the MC budget for the postpartum aid code.

## Additional Information:

Upon release of the defect, a list of the affected cases will be posted and a revision to the CIT will be released.

## **County Action:**

When processing an affected case and the postpartum individual is active on another program that provides full scope MC, discontinue the postpartum aid code 76. If a Notice of Action (NOA) went out to the customer granting them Postpartum extension benefits, a discontinuance NOA needs to be sent to the customer.

Until the Defect is released, when a worker is running an online EDBC and determines that the postpartum aid code should not apply, an override can be completed to fail the MC budget for the postpartum aid code.
