JOB DESCRIPTION

The Lead Implementation Coordinator will report to the Implementation Manager. The Lead Implementation Coordinator will have significant knowledge and experience in the best practices of organizational transformation of counties to information systems and governance structures. Incumbents will assist the Implementation Manager in understanding and addressing the human factors affecting the consortium's ability to reach its strategic goals and by gathering input from the counties and being a conduit for communication. The Lead Implementation Coordinator will oversee highly complex and sensitive assignments.

The Lead Implementation Coordinator will provide coaching and direction to the Implementation Coordinators in guiding counties through the organizational transformation to a statewide system and consortium. The Implementation Lead will supervise a team of Implementation Coordinators that provide on-going support before and after go-live.
