CA-48513 Update EDBC Logic to Auto-Test for 4M

- Review/Discussion
- Presenter: Tisha
- Scheduled for 22.09 Release
- Regional votes required; will be due in 3 weeks
- SCR previously reviewed and voted on, however an escalation was submitted and updates to the SCR were made
- This SCR was created to streamline the auto-test to Medi-Cal (MC) aid code 4M for Foster Care minors aging out of FC
- **Question:** If there is another Former Foster Youth (FFY) in the case, will the FFY will be added to the MC block and how will system establish the renewal month as there might be two RE due months?
 - **Response:** Not updating RE logic with this SCR. There will be separate blocks for each FFY.
- **Question:** If the FC case is marked confidential, it will add a new MC program on the case, will the MC program not be confidential, but the FC will?

- **Response:** A new case will be created, and it will not be marked confidential. The FC case confidentiality status remains untouched.
- **Question:** For cases, not marked confidential, will it still create a new case?
 - **Response:** This whole process will create a new MC case regardless if the FC case is confidential or not.
- **Question:** When the system runs an auto-test, will it run a duplicate aid check? There are minors that are receiving aid on other cases or in other Counties.
 - **Response:** There is no existing batch that checks for duplicate aid. However, EDBC rules does check if the minor has any other MC in the system and if so, will discontinue the FFM. The other case will remain active (ex: CalWORKS case)
- **Question:** If the minor is a runaway, how will the system know to run logic?
 - **Response:** If child is disc from cash based FC, they are not discontinued due to runaway.
 - This is only based on aging out
 - If FC is maintaining a MC case only, must follow the current County process.
 - This auto-test logic is only for disc FC child to FFM. If no FC program is open, the auto-test wont occur.
 - Even if the FC program is a \$0 grant, as long as the FC program is open, it will auto-test the FFY MC program
- **Question:** What if they have an existing case number? For example: active CF. Will the 4M block open on that existing case or will it create a whole new case number?
 - **Response:** A new case number will be created. The program will not auto-test on the CF case.

Worker Assignment

- The MC worker would need to have the position detail page completed to accept FFY Auto-test cases.
- Position detail is controlled by the County
- SCR originally would have CalSAWS send a CRFI to see which Counties wanted to opt in to have a one-time data change update MC worker position details for this effort.
- Do Counties need to opt in all workers or can a County state which MC workers? In LA County, they do not want all MC workers to be assigned these cases as they have MC workers in DCFS. They only want the MC workers in DPSS.

- **Note:** LA County requested to have cases auto-test to a specific position in one office as FFY is specialized. The cases would be distributed with internal business processes. Other Counties expressed the same interest.
- **Question:** CalSAWS asked if it is still necessary to do the one-time data change since most Counties only have/want specialized workers?
 - **Response:** Counties asked to have time to discuss and provide response
 - CalSAWS won't update the position detail to specific workers in an office. Most Counties indicated they will update the position detail to one or a few workers manually then will follow internal County procedures.
- Journal entry will be created in the FC case and the new MC case
- The FFY MC Cover letter will be available in the template repository for all Counties.
 - Used to be only available for LA
- **Question:** If there is a need to request a new task to be created, can it be done?
 - **Response:** The new task only creates in the FC case, not in the new MC case
 - Most Counties would like a new task in the MC case
 - There is a new assignment worker indicator on the workload inventory to alert a case was auto-tested
 - The indicator is displayed until its clicked
 - The second task could be incorporated to this SCR in the new MC case.
 - This second task could be turned off if a County doesn't need/want it
- **Question:** If the FC youth ages out, returns (as they can age out at 18 and 21), will the auto-test open another new MC case or reopen the previous MC case?
 - **Response:** It will open a new MC case every time the FC minor disc from FC for aging out
 - Action Item: CalSAWS will see if auto-test can look for and reopen a previous MC case instead of opening a new MC case and if another SCR would be required for this due to implementation date for this SCR.
