CalSAWS collects Tribe information in the Individual Demographic Detail page when the answer to the question 'Is this person a member of a Federally – Recognized Indian Tribe?' is "Yes". This page collects the State to which the Tribe belongs as well as the Tribe Name. The Tribe names selectable in CalSAWS include both Federal-Recognized Tribes and State-Recognized Tribes. CalSAWS communicates Tribe Name code to CalHEERS via eHIT in an Eligibility Determination Request (EDR) transaction. Although State-Recognized Tribes are in eHIT, when CalSAWS sends a State-Recognized Tribe in an EDR, CalHEERS returns an error message, 'VALIDATION ERROR: The code provided for TribeNameCode does not exist for SAWS Case Person: XX'.

Federal-Recognized Tribe 'Mdewakanton Sioux Indians' is duplicated in eHIT with both Tribe code 255 and 256. Tribe Name 'Mdewakanton Sioux Indians' (255) and 'Minnesota Mdewakanton Sioux Indians' (256) are two distinct tribes in CalSAWS but represent one single Tribe. Federal-Recognized Tribe 'Table Bluff Reservation-Wiyot Tribe' and Wiyot Tribe (formerly the Table Bluff Reservation-Wiyot Tribe) are in CalSAWS and eHIT as two separate distinct Tribes; however, they represent one single Tribe.

Lastly, CalSAWS contains Tribe Names that are assigned with Governing Body as a State-Recognized Tribe (ST) when the Tribe Names should be assigned to Governing Body as Federal-Recognized Tribe (FE).

Request:

With CalHEERS Change Request CH174936, CalHEERS is updating Federally-Recognized Tribes which are passed in eHIT. CalHEERS will update Federally-Recognized tribe selection in the CalHEERS portal to align with the Federally-Recognized Tribes listed on NCSL (National Conference of State Legislatures) website. This update will allow the Consumers to select their Federal Tribe and not be required to use "Tribe Not Listed". CalHEERS is removing the duplicate Federally-Recognized tribe, 'Mdewakanton Sioux Indians' (255) from eHIT and renaming 'Minnesota Mdewakanton Sioux Indians' (256) to 'Mdewakanton Sioux Indians' (256). Similarly, CalHEERS is removing Federally-Recognized tribe, 'Table Bluff Reservation-Wiyot Tribe' (Tribe Code 570) from eHIT and will reassign individuals to 'Wiyot Tribe (formerly the Table Bluff Reservation-Wiyot Tribe)' (Tribe Code 647).
