Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	<p>Purpose</p> <p>The purpose of this CIT is to provide CalSAWS counties with the Multi Factor Authentication (MFA) process updates designed to mitigate the risk of One Time Password (OTP) emails getting blocked by county email servers.</p> <p>Background</p> <p>Several counties have recently encountered an issue where the CalSAWS OTP emails were blocked by the county email servers due to the domain being unknown or because specific IPs were not whitelisted in the email servers. To mitigate the risk of counties blocking OTP emails, the CalSAWS project will reserve dedicated IP addresses exclusively for OTP emails.</p> <p>Additional Information:</p> <p>A separate AWS Simple Email Service (SES) will be created by the CalSAWS project which will be dedicated for OTP Email service. This change applies to all counties and is scheduled for implementation on 05/06/2022.</p> <p>OTP emails from CalSAWS will be sent from the following sub-domain and IP Addresses:</p> <p>Sub-domain:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> login.calsaws.org
