SCR CA-209184 - Processing Eligibility Determinations for the 250% WDP

- SCR Reviewed with the committee
- Targeted for the CalSAWS 22.11 Release
- Committee will get the full 3 week review period to provide approval
- Questions asked during design overview:
 - **Question:** Will staff receive a MEDS alert or task when an individual turns 65 and begin receiving SSA Retirement (converted from SSA Disability)?
 - **Response:** Not sure if there is a MEDS alert generated. Staff will need to confirm with the customer or review the SSA Award letter.

Important Points

- **Question:** Regarding the SSI/SSP income test, is there a page where staff can record the living arrangement to determine the payment standard?
 - **Response:** The payment standard is stored in the system and EDBC rules determine the eligibility.

SCR CA-243263 Update MAGI Case Linking Logic for Inbound eHIT Transaction for Purged CalSAWS Cases

- SCR discussed for the 1st time with the committee
- It will be sent out to the committee as an FYI once the design is finalized
- This will implement a technical change on the back-end needed due to the purging of cases that will begin in August 2022
- Once a case is purged, it cannot have a MC program assigned to it therefore case linkage cannot occur for purged cases
- Additional logic will be added to confirm if the CalSAWS case number is purged
- If case is purged, the case linkage will be broken
- Questions asked during design overview:
 - **Question:** When does the system consider a case to be purged? At identified or Complete?
 - **Response** – When a case has a status of *In Process* or *Complete*, it is considered purged. A case with a status of *Identified* is not considered to be purged.
 - **Question:** – What causes a case to be purged?
 - **Response** – Cases need to meet certain criteria to be purged (such as no case activity for 6 years, etc.).
 - **Question:** What happens when a referral is linked to a case that has been *Identified* to be purged and there is a delay in the processing?
 - **Response** – The purge process will stop once a referral is linked to a case, regardless of whether the case status is pending.
