**Memorandum Purpose:**

This memorandum is intended to convey the batch EDBC scope for SCR CA-245693 Batch EDBC for Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) for Income In-Kind (IIK) for 2022-2023, county actions and schedule for the referenced program changes.

**Scope:**

Per All County Letter (ACL) 22-39, policy will be implemented in CalSAWS through SCR CA-242913 as part of the 22.06.14 release on 06/14/2022.

To minimize the work required by the counties, the project will take the following actions:

**1. Batch:**

- a. Run a Batch EDBC in Targeted program mode, for all cases with CalWORKs and RCA programs with an active or ineligible program person who has an income record of type 'Income In-Kind', effective for 07/2022. The Targeted program mode will process EDBC for CW, RCA, CF, NB, IN, and DV programs from the identified cases which includes all the CW/CF(including NB) combo cases.  
Note: Because EDBC applies the lower of the standard amount and the Amount Provided, both populations are included.  
Exclude the following cases:
  - i) The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the program.
  - ii) The program has a SAR7 Due Month of 06/2022 and the report status is Sent, Received, or Incomplete
  - iii) CW/RCA EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-242913 went to production.

- b. Run the above population with run reason 'In-kind Income COLA'.

**2. NOAs:**

All notices will be sent to the Central Printing facility the night of the batch EDBC process.

**3. Journal:**

CalSAWS: A journal entry will be created for each program run by the batch EDBC process. This will be the standard journal entry added by the batch EDBC process.  
Journal Category: Eligibility

Journal Type: Batch EDBC

Short Description: Batch EDBC ran for [MONTH/YEAR].

<p>Cases where CW or RCA programs that meets all the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>i) An active or ineligible program person for the 07/2022 benefit month</li> <li>ii) That person has an income record of type 'Income In-Kind'</li> <li>iii) That income has a begin date prior to 07/01/2022</li> <li>iv) That income has an end date on or after 07/01/2022, or no end-date</li> <li>v) That income Amount Provided field is set to 'Yes'</li> <li>vi) That income has a Reported Amount that matches the 2021 - 2022 IIK table lookup: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) The household size is determined by the 'MAP Family Unit Size' from the latest saved EDBC, effective for the 07/2022 benefit month</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>Review the cases and determine if the amount record(s) should be updated to the 2022-2023 chart level or another amount.</p>

### **Development Schedule**

1. Deliver the driving query and list queries to the System Test team on 06/06/2022.
2. System Testing will occur between 06/06/2022 and 06/16/2022.
3. Run batch EDBC in production on 06/16/2022.

### **Things to remember about these batch EDBC processes:**

- All impacts from SIRs and SCR's which have not been implemented will continue to occur during the batch processing.
- There are multiple reasons why a program may not be successfully run through batch EDBC processing. Some examples include: No Worker Assigned, Overridden Program Case, and Pending Program/Person/Application. Please review tasks and the Batch Eligibility Report daily.
- The EDBC's will have an EDBC Source of 'Batch EDBC Rules'.
- When a user runs EDBC in which a prior pending month exists, the EDBC will have a type of Read-Only. When running Batch EDBC that restriction does not apply and these EDBC's will not be Read-Only.
- Any updates or lack of updates made/not made to cases will impact the batch EDBC results. This means programs may be discontinued (due to non-compliances, etc.) unexpectedly.
- All notices will be generated normally.

### **County Action:**

- Review cases included in the lists and take necessary action.
- Review the Batch Eligibility Report and action cases which could not be processed. This report is an on-request report available under Global: Reports > Local: On Request > Task: Administrative. If you do not see this report, please contact your Security

Administrator for rights. To see cases not processed select a status of 'Not Processed' on the Reports Parameters pages

**Schedule Considerations:**

- System will not be down during batch processing on Thursday, June 16, 2022.
- Batch jobs scheduled for each evening will run after the batch EDBC process completes.
- Approximately 1700 active programs will be processed in CalSAWS for the benefit month of 07/2022.
- Approximately 50,000 programs processed per hour via batch EDBC.
- The System cannot run batch EDBC processing during the following:
  - Main Payroll
  - Foster Care Main Payroll
  - SAR7 Discontinuance
  - RE Discontinuance
  - 10-day Discontinuance
  - CalFresh Recertification Discontinuance

**Timeline:**

- Expected CalSAWS Batch EDBC processing: 06/16/2022.
