Description: (Including any step-by-step instructions)	Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to notify all counties about the County Sharing Program which is designed to facilitate the sharing of county business processes across counties. Background As the CalWIN Counties continue towards their CalSAWS implementations, there is a greater need for county sharing to aid in decision making around county business processes. The CalSAWS Regional Managers (RMs) are sponsoring the County Sharing Program to provide a county perspective to CalWIN Counties on CalSAWS functions. Additional Information The County Sharing Program will focus on events and informational sharing. Events will focus on how Migrated Counties use CalSAWS to accomplish their goals as County Welfare Departments. For items that do not require events, RMs will collect information for counties using a standard County Information Sharing (CIS) process. The goal is to share county business processes, best practices, how counties use
	CalSAWS functionality, and to provide clarity on their decision making.

County Sharing Events

The RMs will begin scheduling events in August and will continue as needed through the CalWIN Migration phase. Requests will be prioritized based on the requestor's wave number and availability of resources. Events will be held using Zoom or Microsoft Teams for virtual events. In-person events can be scheduled for topics that would be better demonstrated in-person. Funding for travel will need to be coordinated with the CalSAWS PMO Fiscal team as needed.

County Information Sharing

The CalSAWS RMs have created a standard email request template and process for County Information Sharing. Requests will include information in the form of a Menti poll and/or links to the [County Share Resources] folder to collect materials. Results of the requests will be emailed to all counties and will include a Web Portal link to the Menti poll results as well as any materials collected.

A kickoff event will be held on August 9,2022 from 10:00 am to 10:50 am to provide an overview of the program and an opportunity to receive clarifications.

County Action

- Counties will receive a Kick-off meeting invitation with a flyer attached. Counties can forward to others in their county as needed.
- CalWIN Counties can reach out to their Regional Manager(s) to request County Sharing events or County Information Sharing requests.
- Designated CalSAWS county teams can assist other counties by participating in County Sharing events and providing responses to County Information Sharing email requests.
