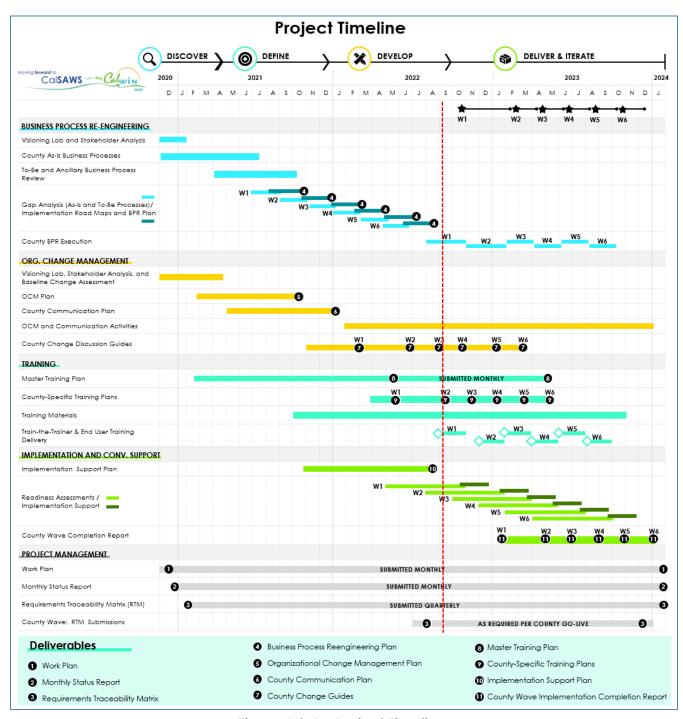


Figure 6.3-1 - Project Timeline
