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Description:	<p>Purpose</p> <p>The purpose of this CIT is to provide interim instructions to CalSAWS Counties regarding Ukrainian Parolees who arrived in the United States due to displacement from the war in Ukraine.</p> <p>Background</p> <p>ACWDL issued on July 6, 2022, provides guidance to determine eligibility for Ukrainian and non-Ukrainian individuals who may be eligible to receive assistance. The Uniting For Ukraine (U4U) Program provides a pathway for Ukrainian citizens and immediate family members to enter the U.S. as humanitarian parolees for a period of up to two years.</p> <p>On May 21, 2022, President Biden signed into law the Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act (AUSAA), 2022, authorizing Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) to provide resettlement assistance and other benefits to specific Ukrainian populations and non-Ukrainian individuals displaced from Ukraine. These populations are eligible to receive ORR and mainstream federal benefits (e.g., Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Medicaid, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, and Supplemental Security Income). This Act includes humanitarian parolees who arrived under the U4U Program if they</p>
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resettle during the eligibility time frame between February 24, 2022, and September 30, 2023.

Per [ORR PL 22-13](#), the initial date of ORR benefit eligibility for Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (UHPs) and Non-Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (NUHPs) is May 21, 2022, or the individual's date of humanitarian parole, whichever is later. These individuals, and their designated family members, are eligible for ORR benefits and services until the end of the individual's parole term, unless otherwise amended by law or the individual gains another ORR-eligible category or status.

County Action:

CA-232960 has been expanded to include new Ukrainian Parolee section codes provided with ORR PL 22-13. The following steps can be used to obtain eligibility for this parolee population, as appropriate, until implementation of CA-232960.

On the **Citizenship Status Detail** page:

- 1) Select **I-94** from the **Document** field
- 2) Select **212(d)(5)** from the **Section Code** field
- 3) Select **Parolee-One year or more** from the **Parolee Type** field
- 4) Complete the remaining necessary information on the **Citizenship Status Detail** page.

EDBC has the logic to determine program eligibility based on the **Document** and **Section Code**. If the desired eligibility is not received based on the ACWDL direction, an override can be completed to grant desired eligibility.

CalFresh

Take a Negative Action to deny the person/case if not eligible to CalFresh benefits based on the ACWDL instructions.

Follow the county process to track cases and discontinue when the special immigrant document expires and to journal any actions taken.

Additional Medi-Cal Information:

In addition, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) published [MEDIL 22-30](#) on July 18, 2022 which references the types of Immigration documents for Ukrainian arrivals. The following instructions are for Medi-Cal only cases.

Ukrainian citizens or nationals arriving in the U.S. as humanitarian parolees are eligible for full scope Medi-Cal and will typically have one of the following immigration documents:

- Foreign passport with DHS/CBP admission stamp indicating "PAROLED" and noting:

- o Uniting for Ukraine or "U4U" or
- o Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolee or "UHP" or
- o "PAR" or
- o DT

(For individuals with a foreign passport that do not have an I-94, select the document type of 'Passport Only-Not Annotated' on the Citizenship Detail page. If

The Citizenship Detail page for a MC and CAPI individual where the CAPI individual's Document Type is PRUCOL should not be changed. Changing the Document Type to an I-94 or I-688B/I-766 will impact the individual's eligibility for CAPI.
