Purpose

The purpose of this CIT is to provide all Counties with information on a focused training for Community Based Organizations (CBO) that will be using the BenefitsCal (BC) portal. This training will be open to all CalSAWS county CBOs and can be forwarded as appropriate for awareness.

Background

Beginning in September of 2021, the CalSAWS project began rolling out the new BenefitsCal system replacing the C4Yourself (C4Y), Your Benefits Now (YBN), and MyBenefits CalWIN (MyBCW) applications where customers could apply for and manage benefits. CBOs are able to submit applications for customers through BC after they are approved by either a county or CDSS.

Additional Information:

The BC team previously scheduled a CBO Awareness Training on September 22, 2022, for Wave 1 counties (Placer and Yolo) CBOs to provide the workflow for the new process. The CalSAWS counties and CBOs who were already on the BC system have requested access to this session.

The invitation for the CBO training is being made available to all CalSAWS counties who currently have CBOs using the BC system for application submission.
