Timeline for Waves 3 and 4



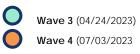

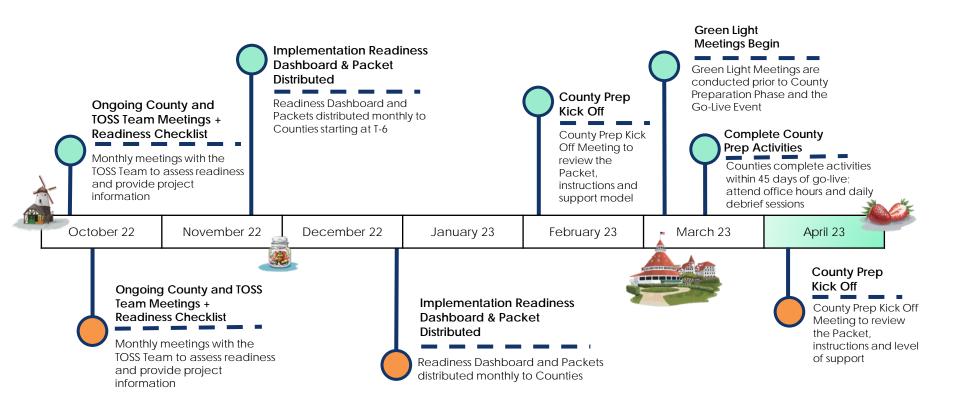
Timeline for Waves 5 and 6

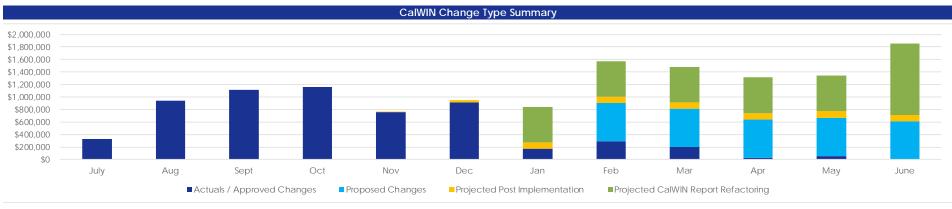

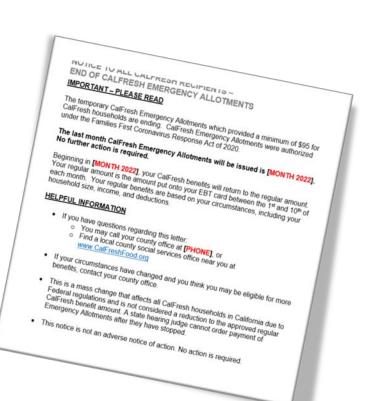
11. Policy Update

Both SAWS are meeting with CDSS around the timing of sending the mass mailer.



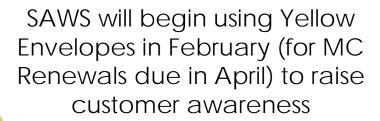
COVID 19 State of Emergency Ending as of Feb 28, 2023

PHE Update

The Federal Government has approved another PHE extension effective October 13, 2022, for up to 90 days.

- Therefore January 11, 2023, would mark the end of the current 90day PHE extension.
- Also due to the CMS commitment providing a 60-day advance notice to announce the PHE conclusion, another PHE update from CMS/DHCS is not expected prior to November 12, 2022.

PHE unwinding period is likely to begin February 2023

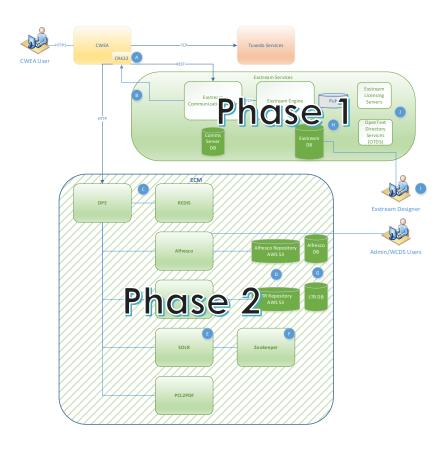

- Read Only CalWIN and Simulation

Overview

- Objective: Migrate Notice CalWIN to AWS
 - Upgrade Software Stack (Alfresco, Exstream, etc.)
 - Migrate Database from Oracle to AWS PostgreSQL
- Phase 1: Exstream
 - Go Live: June 5, 2022
 - Improved performance to product documents from 10-15 seconds to 4-5 seconds
- Phase 2: ECM
 - Go live: October 17, 2022
 - Database Migration of ~13B rows
 - No County-reported issues, i.e. no disruption to county business,



CalWIN Read Only PPM 62403

- CalWIN project 62403 was opened to provide a read only environment post migration allowing counties continued access to the CalWIN data. This environment included simulation to assist in scenarios where EBDC needed to be run in CalWIN after migration
- As counties migrate, Read Only will be applied to their counties which will provide access once conversion dependencies are completed
- On 10/24/2022, all functionality related to Read Only was implemented into production. This logic is triggered based on migration date

On 10/28/2022 in the early morning hours, Yolo and Placer came back online successfully as Read Only
