Purpose

Background

The Change Readiness Surveys are intended to assess change metrics that help support the CalWIN Counties Change Management strategies and activities. The Change Readiness surveys will be distributed at 12, 9, 6, and 3 months prior to Go-Live. The results will assist in driving the organizational change management (OCM) approach to improve communications. Only internal stakeholders from each county will be assessed in the surveys.
