Purpose

The purpose of this CIT is to inform Counties that effective immediately, the number of Web Portal licenses provisioned to each County will be increasing from 12 to 75.

Background

The CalSAWS Web Portal is a central location for communication and collaboration between the CalSAWS project and County partners. Historically each County has been allotted 12 Web Portal licenses. RCM Web Portal and other special web portal groups will not count toward allotted 75 County Web Portal licenses. To support broader communication and information distribution Counties have requested increased access for County staff. CalSAWS has responded and access has been increased to 75 to support further collaboration and information sharing with County partners.

CalSAWS will be working to continuously evolve communications to counties through a variety of different Strike Team initiatives. Input from Regional representatives, through the Communications and Web Portal County focus group sessions, has directly influenced priority activities and communication evolution initiatives. We thank you for your continued partnership.

Additional Information



Regional representatives participated in a Web Portal County Focus Group Session on September 13, 2022. Participants provided input on what's working, what could be improved and voted on priorities from a County perspective. Three areas bubbled to the top of the list and have been shared with the Web Portal Strike Team for consideration when developing next steps.

Each County currently has 12 Web Portal Access licenses.


Reorganize Content
