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Description:	<p>Purpose</p> <p>The purpose of this CIT is to notify CalSAWS counties that a one-time list is posted for CA-242010 Increase to the Asset Limits for Medically Needy (MN) Sneed Non-MAGI Medi-Cal (MC) Programs.</p> <p>Note: CalWIN updated these changes with PPM 60783 – Release 69 (May 2022), therefore, Yolo and Placer are not included on this list.</p> <p>Background</p> <p>Effective July 1, 2022, ACWDL 22-13 updated the asset limits for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal programs. This includes Medically Needy (MN) Sneed Non-MAGI Medi-Cal Programs per ACWDL 22-15.</p> <p>SCR CA-242010 was created to increase to the Asset Limits for Medically Needy (MN) Sneed Non-MAGI Medi-Cal Programs. Effective July 1, 2022, the asset (property) limits for Medically Needy (MN) Sneed Non-MAGI Medi-Cal programs, increased to \$130,000 for the first individual in the Mini Budget Unit (MBU) and \$65,000 for each additional individual in the MBU, up to ten people.</p> <p>Additional Information</p>
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	<p>A one-time County list was created to assist the counties in identifying cases where at least one Individual failed the MC Property Sneeede test for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal, effective on or after July 01, 2022 for the reason of over resources.</p> <p>Note: Overdue Mandatory Verifications for Property will result in EDBC failing the individual due to 'Failed Property'. As cases are reviewed, check the case for overdue verifications and update as appropriate. Per DHCS, verifications requested during the Public Health Emergency (PHE) are no longer valid and once the PHE ends, new verifications should be requested at the customer's annual renewal. Once updated, re-run EDBC to allow for any updates to eligibility.</p> <p>The list contains the standard columns plus any additional columns as listed below.</p> <p>List Criteria: At least one Individual failed the Medi-Cal Property Sneeede test for Non-MAGI Medi-Cal, effective on or after July 2022 for Over Resources but the Property Total was under the new property limit as of July 1, 2022.</p> <p>Additional Columns: Benefit Month, Individual Name <First Name, Last Name>, CIN, and DOB</p> <p>County Action: Counties should review the cases and determine if the budget should be re-evaluated with the new property limits and if appropriate, rescind the denied/discontinued Individual.</p> <p>List Name: Individuals that Failed for Over Property for MC Property Sneeede Test</p> <p>The list is available at the following location: </p> <p>Please note: The new property limits were updated in CalSAWS effective July 1, 2022. EDBC runs for 07/2022 Benefit Month used the updated property limits for non-Sneeede cases.
