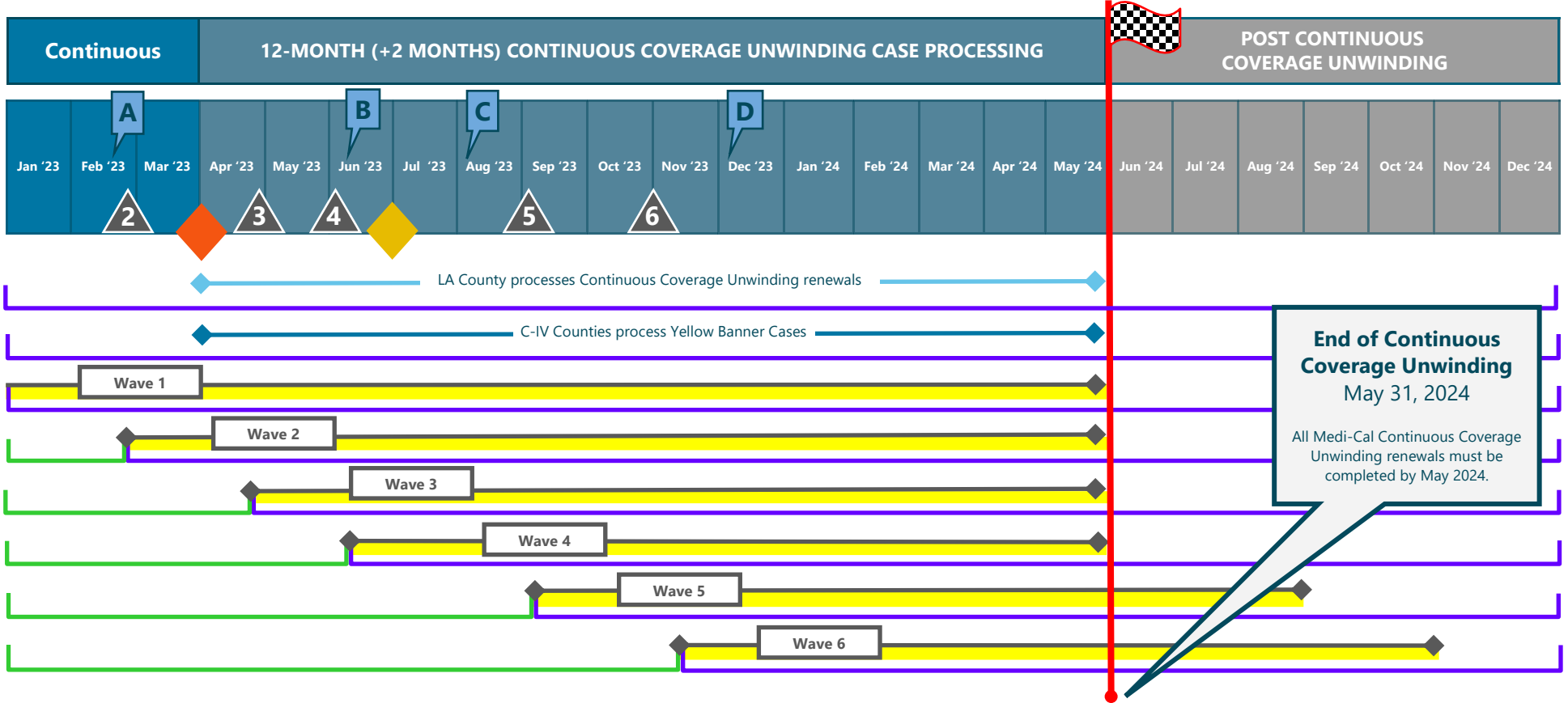


Addressing Medi-Cal Yellow Banner Cases During Continuous Coverage Unwinding Period and Migration



End of Medi-Cal Continuous Coverage Requirement

- The Continuous Coverage protections will be in place until March 31, 2023.
- The 12-month (plus additional two months to complete renewal activities) Continuous Coverage Unwinding period will end May 2024. All unwinding renewals must be completed by May 31, 2024.
- Normal Medi-Cal business processes begins June 2024.
- All counties begin renewal activities for the first **Medi-Cal Continuous Coverage Unwinding renewals** on 4/2023 for cases with renewal Due Month 6/2023.
- If a beneficiary is discontinued during the June renewal, their last day of eligibility will be **June 30, 2023**. The first day the beneficiary will not have Medi-Cal coverage will be **July 1, 2023**.

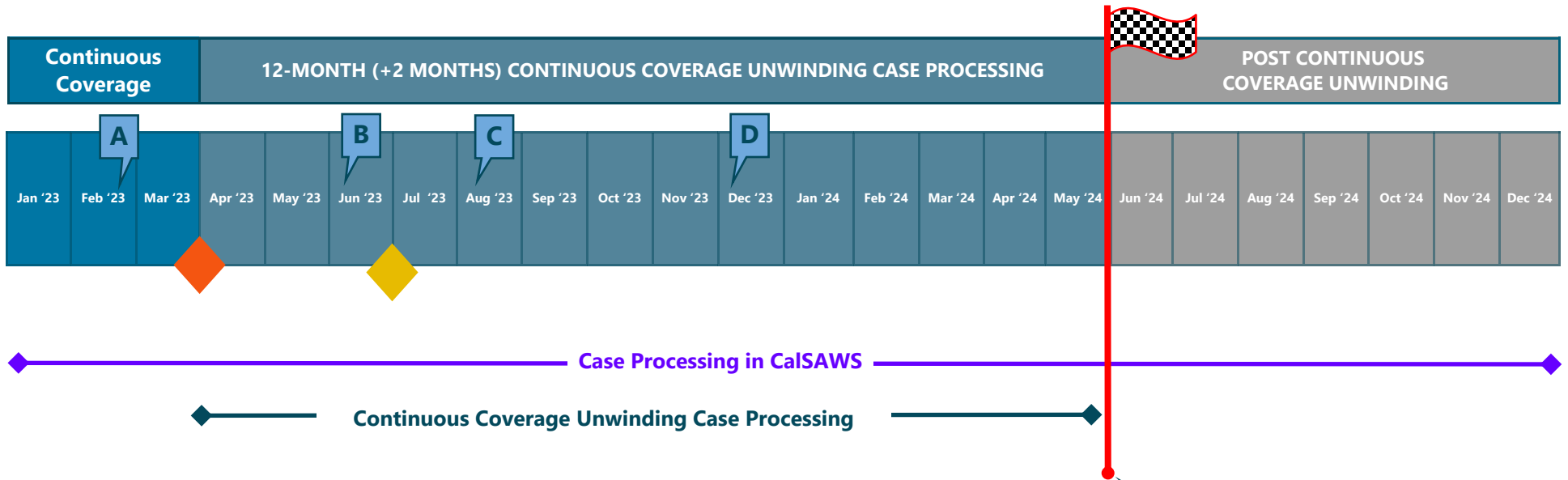

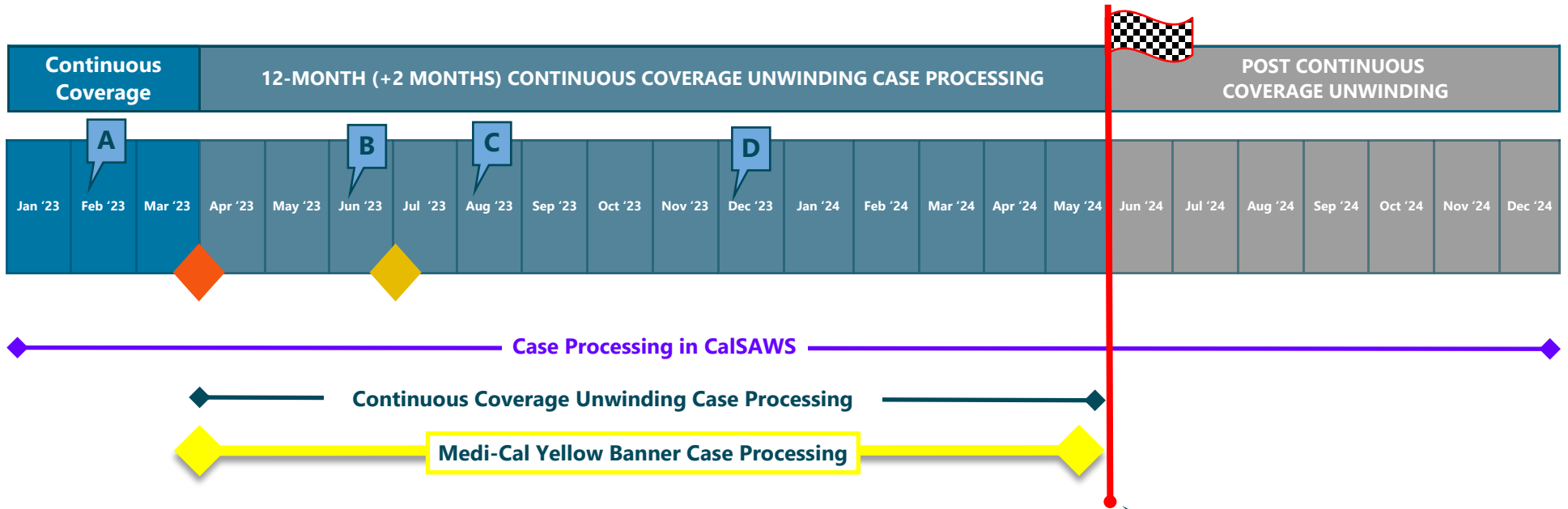
End of Continuous Coverage Unwinding
