	Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to notify CalSAWS Wave 1 counties (Yolo and Placer) that one-time lists for Defect CA-251779 have been posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal. Background A conversion defect was identified for Disabled Adult Children (DAC) for the Wave 1 counties. The CalWIN and CalSAWS systems have different ways of inputting DAC income. In CalWIN workers are to adjust/disregard the entire MC Social Security SS) income for the DAC person as there is no place for workers to enter the parent's SSA Title II Income to adjust for the DAC. Per policy, DAC does not automatically get the entire SS income exempted. In CalSAWS, the portion of the SS Income that should be adjusted (the income related to the parent's SSA Title II income) is stored in the Income Adjustment field with DAC/COLA Type, then the EDBC will subtract the income Adjustment from the SS income amount. For DAC cases that converted for Wave 1 counties, CalSAWS has updated the income Adjustment amount to be equal to the Reported Amount in CalWIN for DAC individuals. Some of the DAC cases that converted have converted SS Income, the DAC questions are answered "Yes", and they are currently on a DAC (aid code 6C or

6A). The Adjusted Amount was updated on those cases with Data Change Request (DCR) CA-255391.

Some cases have converted SS Income where the DAC questions are not answered "Yes," but they were converted over as DAC aid code 6C or 6A. Since these questions are required for DAC eligibility and were answered as "No" or were not answered, a list was created for the worker to review and determine if these individuals are DAC eligible.

Additionally, there were some DAC individuals whose aid code changed from a 6C or 6A during conversion.

To assist Wave 1 counties the following lists were created:

- A list to identify the cases where the DAC questions were answered "No" or left blank
- A list of DAC individuals whose aid code changed upon conversion

The lists contain the standard columns and additional columns of CIN and Aid code.

For the cases of DAC individuals whose aid code changed upon conversion, please review the cases, and determine if the transition from the DAC (6A/6C) aid code is correct.
