Figure 1.2.2-2 – Overall CalSAWS.org Usage Trend





Figure 4.1.1-1 – CalSAWS Test Summary









Figure 5.1.3-1 – Contra Costa County Refactoring Development Burndown



7.3 Deviations from Plan/Adjustments

 - o Reconfiguration require use of temporary alternate IP Addressing space to accommodate counties Data Center move
 - All changes completed
 - Risk probability has been lowered and will remain a watchlist item.
- Created Risk 283 for Fresno County technical enablement due to carrier delays impacting Circuit delivery
 - o Ordered 2 circuits for Fresno County to provide WAN connectivity to CalSAWS
 - o Lumen had provided a delivery date of early March which has now changed to late April 2023 citing carrier delay
 - o AT&T has not provided any FOC / delivery date
 - o Unless 1 of 2 circuits gets delivered by March 10, 2023, technical enablement and integration with county will be delayed resulting in delays to downstream activities.
 - AT&T circuit delivered, pending activation on March 7, 2023
- Created Risk 286 for Santa Cruz County technical enablement to support IPT readiness due to delays accessing the site and County subcontractor resource availability for detailed design and integration discussions

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- o Rescheduled change CHG0038866 for implementation activities for February 23, 2023. Implementation is dependent on completion of detailed design discussion on February 16, 2023
 - Technical changes completed as scheduled.
 - Connectivity troubleshooting ongoing as County firewall is unable to propagate traffic through it
 - County to escalate and raise ticket priority to ensure close monitoring and faster resolution
- o Unless connectivity is established for all services for IPT readiness by March 3, 2023, IPT begin of March 15, 2023, may be impacted
- o Due to lack of a firm resolution date; we have identified workarounds that will reduce impact to IPT testing.
 - IPT team will start with validating Outbound Jobs (not impacted)
