


Figure 4.1-1 – Weekly WBT Training Report – Contra Costa County




Figure 4.1-2 – Weekly WBT Training Report – Santa Clara County




Figure 4.1-3 - Weekly WBT Training Report - Tulare County

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


Figure 4.1-4 - Weekly WBT Training Report - Orange County




Figure 4.1-6 – Weekly WBT Training Report – Santa Barbara County




Figure 4.1-7 – Weekly WBT Training Report – San Diego County

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


Figure 4.1-8 – Weekly WBT Training Report – San Mateo County




Figure 4.1-9 – Weekly WBT Training Report – Santa Cruz County




Figure 4.1-10 – Weekly WBT Training Report – Solano County




Figure 4.1-11 – Weekly ILT Training Report – Contra Costa County




Figure 4.1-12 – Weekly ILT Training Report – Santa Clara County




Figure 4.1-13 – Weekly ILT Training Report – Tulare County




Figure 6.3-1 - Project Timeline
