## **County Action:**

Workers should evaluate individuals on the list for the following:

- Social Security Retirement (SSR)/Social Security Disability (SSD) should have their income record updated to indicate that the social security income was converted from SSD to SSR by selecting the 'Medi-Cal 250% Working Disabled: Converted from Social Security Disability?' drop-down on the Income Detail page, if applicable.
- Veteran's Disability-Partial income type is now exempted by the system in the 250% WDP.
- IHSS-Wages Caregiver for Spouse/Minor income type is now considered a work activity for the purposes of the 250% WDP.

If an individual is eligible to the 250% WDP, the worker should grant the benefits and send a notice of action to the beneficiary.
