Current Design:

The Automated Regression Test (ART) Suite is used to verify the most highly used functionality of the CalSAWS online application. The ART Suite is primarily expanded through the SCR process based on review and analysis of the new or updated business functionality.

> ART Coverage is tracked at the transaction level, with a focus on the most highly used transactions by production volume. As of March 2023 the tiered transaction coverage was as follows:

Tier 1: 100.00% Tier 2: 95.16% Tier 3: 89.56% Tier 4: 60.25% Tier 5: 27.33%

New coverage of transactions that move into Tier 1 or Tier 2, either as the result of newly-implemented functionality or altered usage patterns in the production system, is managed through the release-based 'Execution & Maintenance' SCRs on a two-month delay (ex., CA-259511, CA-259513).

Request: Expand the coverage of the ART Suite to include:

- 1. Tier 2 transactions that could not previously be targeted due to technical limitations (ex., Form generation)
- 2. All Tier 3 transactions
- 3. The top 20% of Tier 4 transactions by volume as of March 2023

Recommendation:

Analyze, design, and develop automated scripts to cover additional Tier 2, Tier 3, and Tier 4 transactions as outlined in the Request:

- 1. Review and analyze March 2023 metric data to identify the Tier 2, 3, and 4 transactions to be covered. Technical Note: This shall exclude transactions that were previously identified and incorporated into the scope of the following SCRs: CA-253159, CA-256052, CA-259627, CA-256633.
- 2. For each targeted transaction:
- a. Design an end-to-end manual test scenario targeting the transaction.
- b. Document any technical updates to the CAT Framework required to automate each test scenario.
- 3. Build the new automated scripts:
- a. Develop automated regression test scripts for each test scenario.
- b. Implement the technical changes to the CAT Framework identified in Rec. 2b.
- 4. Merge the new scripts into the automated Regression Test Suite per the standard review & delivery process.

Technical Note: This includes peer review and a subsequent technical review to determine and configure (1) the test environments and (2) counties in which each script can be executed. The latter information is captured in the Regression Script Inventory on the CalSAWS SharePoint.

A repository of automated regression scripts has been created and organized into test suites, with the purpose of validating major and minor version releases before they are deployed to production.

This includes coverage of the CalSAWS core online application, CalSAWS FDS and BenefitsCal APIs.

Request:

The automated regression scripts should be executed and maintained on a regular basis, to validate the quality of each system version before it is released to production.

When the Regression Test Suite is run against the core CalSAWS application in a test environment with API services, the related API scripts should also be executed.

Recommendation:

- 1. Execute the major release automated regression suite against the 23.07 major version build on a regular basis.
- Assumption: No more than 5 runs per week, averaged across the baseline / major release cycle.
- Note: This includes all ST Regression, CH Regression, and Ad Hoc Regression runs during the baseline / major release cycle.
- 2. Execute the major release automated regression suite against the final build for the 23.07 major version, prior to the build being deployed to production.
- Assumption: 1 run per major release.
- Note: This includes only the Major Release regression test runs in the staging environment.
- 3. Execute the priority / minor release automated regression suite against the final build of each applicable 23.07 minor version, prior to the build being deployed to production.
- Assumption: No more than 3 runs per week, averaged across the priority release cycle.
- Note: This includes all Pre-Prod Regression test runs (ST and/or AT) for applicable priority / minor version and RWR releases.
- 4. Update the test scripts within the major and minor release automated regression suites as needed to account for intentional design changes that would otherwise generate false negative results.
- Assumption: No more than 40% of the regression test scripts need to be updated in this manner.
- Note: This includes all scripts that target the CalSAWS core online application, and the CalSAWS FDS and BenefitsCal APIs.
- 5. Develop new test scripts and/or expand the scope of existing test scripts to provide coverage of Tier 1-3 transactions ("top 80%" by production usage volume).
- Assumption: No more than 14 new transactions per release cycle
- Note: Script development will trail production assessment by 2 months (ex., January production data is gathered in February; coverage gaps to be closed by end of March)

- 6. Develop new automated scripts in response to high-priority production defects that are resolved and released through post-23.07 priority or RWR releases.
- Assumption: No more than 4 medium complexity defect / scenarios per release cycle

San Mateo converted into CalSAWS on 07/03/2023, the CalWIN counties San Mateo administered CAPI enter an Unearned Income record that is used in the CF EDBC determination.

Sonoma and Alameda County converts into CalSAWS in Wave 5; Go-Live Date is 09/04/2023. The changes from CA-247105 (Remove CAPI OPA and Unearned Income Records Associated to CAPI Administered by San Mateo County) did not apply to Sonoma and Alameda County.

Request:

When San Mateo converted into CalSAWS, the CF EDBC will count the Unearned Income record in the CF budget (resulting in the CAPI grant being counted twice and may discontinue the CF program for over-income). If the Unearned Income record does not result in an Over Income, the CF program will reduce benefits.

- 1. Apply a data change to remove the Unearned Income record for CAPI for all members in an active CAPI program for a county with CAPI administered by San Mateo County.

- 2. When a user processes a CW/CF/RCA SAR7 or a CW/CF RE in the month after the report was due and it results in a negative change, CalSAWS does not create a Read-Only EDBC for that month. A regular EDBC is created that applies the negative change even though 10-day notice was not provided.
- 3. The calculation of unearned income when CF EDBC is re-run for a benefit month currently uses the most beneficial (i.e., lowest) amount from the previously run EDBC for the cash programs that are treated as unearned income for that month when:
- a. the EDBC run date is past the intake date for the program; and,
- b. the benefit month is not the come-up month; and,
- c. a valid recent EDBC for the benefit month exists.
- Request:
- 1. Allow CF EDBC to apply changes for the first month of a new CF certification period even if those changes are made after the 10-day NOA deadline and result in a negative change.
- 2. When processing a late CF SAR7, CW SAR7/RE, or RCA SAR7 in a month after the report was due when benefits have not yet been issued, do not apply negative changes without giving 10-day notice. EDBC should return a Read Only EDBC until a month is processed where timely notice can be provided even if it is after the month the report was due.
- 3. Use the most recent (not the most beneficial) EDBC from the cash program as unearned income when rerunning CF EDBC for the first month of a new CF SAR period if CF benefits have already been issued for the month.

Recommendation:

1. Update EDBC so that when a user processes a CF RE in the month the RE is due and it is after the 10-day NOA cutoff for the next month and the result is a negative change, CalSAWS will create a Regular (not Read Only) EDBC and will apply the negative change and set the EDBC Run Reason to RE.

(Note: This only applies to CF RE. The rest of "Current Design #1" functionality above remains unchanged: when a CW/CF/RCA SAR7 or CW RE is run in the month the RE is due and it is after the 10-day NOA cut-off for the RE month and the result is a negative change, CalSAWS will still create a Read-Only EDBC and the negative change will not be applied.)

2. Update EDBC so that when a user processes a CW/CF/RCA SAR7 or a CW RE in a month after the report is due and benefits have not yet been issued for the month and the result is a negative change, CalSAWS will

create a Read-Only EDBC for that month with the reason 10-Day Negative Action. After benefits have been issued for the month, the EDBC can be re-run to establish an overissuance/overpayment, if needed.

3. Update CF EDBC to use the cash grant amount from the most recent EDBC from the cash program when calculating unearned income if the benefit month being processed is the start of a new SAR period and CF benefits have already been issued for the month. This is necessary in a situation where the SAR report is returned late and the overissuance cannot be established prior to issuing the CF benefits for the month and CF EDBC is being run to recompute the benefits. Existing CF EDBC logic would use the previous cash aid EDBC for the month that has the lowest grant amount rather than the most recent one which might be higher.

CalSAWS displays a soft validation message when running EDBC informing users that "There is no ongoing immunization record for the following child(ren): (Name of Child)" when there exists a child under 6 years old in the case that does not have a immunization record for the benefit month.

If the immunization verification is still pending once 10 days have passed from the Request Date on the Verification Detail page, a MAP grant reduction is imposed at the beginning of the benefit month.

If a child under the age 6 has an Immunization verification that is "Refused", EDBC currently sets the status to 'Denied'/'Discontinued' (Intake/Ongoing) for the CW program persons

'Denied'/'Discontinued' (Intake/Ongoing) for the CW program persons.

Request: Per CalWORKs policy (EAS 40-105.4), verification of immunization is required for all children in the AU under

the age of 6 by the CW participant within the established timeframe of 30 to 45 days. Therefore, CalSAWS must include functionality to automatically provide the required time for parent/caretaker applicants/participants to submit verifications after the case has been approved or reauthorized before 'FTP-Immunization' MAP reduction penalty is imposed.

Per CRPC 2198, CalSAWS should impose the 'FTP-Immunization' MAP reduction penalty in the amount of the parent(s) or caretaker relative within the established timeframe of 30 to 45 days for immunizations that are 'refused' and should not 'Deny' (Intake) or 'Discontinue' (Ongoing) the CW program persons.

- Recommendation:

 1. Impose 'FTP-Immunization' MAP reduction penalty in the amount of the biological/adoptive parent(s) or caretaker relative exerting parental control that are receiving aid.
 - 2. Update CW EDBC to not Deny (Intake) or Discontinue (Ongoing) CW persons when the immunization record has a status of 'Refused'.
 - 3. Impose 'FTP-Immunization' MAP reduction penalty within the established timeframe of 30 to 45 days while Immunization records remain pending or refused.
 - 4. Update trigger of the existing CalWORKs no school/immunization verification NOA.
 - 5. Add CW 2209- IMMUNIZATION GOOD CAUSE REQUEST FORM to the Template Repository for LRS/ CalSAWS.
