Wraparound Program







Wraparound is a program to provide supportive services like In-Home Counseling and other services for the child. Wraparound services may be authorized for children residing with an adoptive parent or an active Adoption Assistance Program (AAP) case, or for children who are residing out of placement or with their biological parent and ineligible to Foster Care.

Wraparound payments are issued through the Auxiliary Authorization pages. CalSAWS requires an active Child Welfare Services (FC, KG or AAP) program in order to use the **Auxiliary Authorization List** and **Auxiliary Authorization Detail** pages to pay Wraparound payments.

The Auxiliary Authorization
List page displays all
Auxiliary Authorization
records for the case.
Clicking the Add button
opens the Auxiliary
Authorization Detail page.



The **Auxiliary Authorization Detail** page is dynamic and additional fields display based on values selected on the page. The details for the wraparound payment are entered on this page.



Once an Auxiliary
Authorization has been
created, the Status History
updates. This is a read-only
field and displays the status
of the Auxiliary
Authorization record.
