Background This communication is to prevent and ensure the County workers where CalSAWS pop-up pages (e.g Forms, Tasks etc.) are not getting blocked due to the browser settings on County workstations. County Action It would be the responsibility of County IT to make the changes in accordance with established County process using County tools for distributing these settings to the client workstations. Counties should ensure the below domains are permitted / whitelisted. Browser settings - These domains need to be added to the proxy and to

the list of trusted sites to allow websites with the below domains to allow

pop-ups.
