Cackground Is a result of Emergency Declarations by the state and federal governments and the enactment of the Families First Coronavirus Response Act, during the Public ealth Emergency (PHE), most Medi-Cal beneficiaries were protected from diverse actions, except for some allowable reasons. The Department of Health are Services (DHCS), CalSAWS and counties utilized manual lists to prevent correct discontinuances. These efforts known as the MEDS Restoration Process to Not Touch list) restored eligibility directly in MEDS on a monthly basis. The MEDS didividuals with an upcoming discontinuance date. Counties reviewed the lists and HCS restored eligibility for individuals unless they were placed in the Do Not Touch st by the county. During the Continuous Coverage Unwinding period, beneficiaries must be given an opportunity to complete a full renewal prior to being discontinued from Medi-Cal. To prevent erroneous discontinuances during the unwinding period, DHCS, CalSAWS and counties will utilize a modified manual restoration process similar to the MEDS Restoration Process.

Each month a query will be run for Medi-Cal programs with a discontinuance date for the upcoming month, excluding any of the following allowable discontinuance reasons:

- Calif. Residence
- Deceased
- Declined Eligible
- Gets AAP
- Gets ARC
- Gets CalWORKs
- Gets Duplicate Aid
- Gets FC
- Gets Kin-GAP
- Gets SSI
- Gets SSI/SSP
- Inter-County Transfer
- Moved out of County (CMSP)
- On Aid Another Case
- Requested Disc
- Failed to Complete Redetermination (new allowable reason)
- Failed to Complete Determination (new allowable reason)

In addition, if the Medi-Cal program meets one of the following conditions it will not be included in the list for possible restoration:

- the renewal has been completed.
- the application date is on or after 04/01/2023, except if the program was an Intercounty Transfer (ICT).

CalSAWS will provide the list to counties and DHCS the first business day after 10-day.
