Important Points

SCR-CA-202054 – Suspend, Disc, reinstate CAPI

- SCR was reviewed
- A suspense action will be created that will suspend CAPI benefits for 12 months max.
- The CAPI case will discontinue/terminate if inactive for 12 months.
- Customer can reinstate CAPI benefits if they re-establish their eligibility within the suspense (12) months without having to re-apply for CAPI.

- Steve Kohler is researching questions below – Is a suspended case counted as an active case on the CA 1037 Report.
- ICT – Is the CAPI case terminated or suspended when discontinued by the sending county for ICT.
- Can there be overlapping suspense periods?

SCR CR-CA 247105 & CA-247106 were reviewed

- Removes OPA and Unearned income records programs administered by San Mateo and Sacramento
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- If OPA or Unearned income is not removed, the CAPI grant will cause CF benefits discontinued or reduce due to double counting CAPI benefits.
- CA-251758 for Sonoma was also reviewed. This SCR is similar to CA-247105 & CA-247106 but for Sonoma County.
