SCR-CA-202054 – Suspend, Disc, reinstate CAPI

- SCR was reviewed
- A suspense action will be created that will suspend CAPI benefits for 12 months max.
- The CAPI case will discontinue/terminate if inactive for 12 months.
- Customer can reinstate CAPI benefits if they re-establish their eligibility within the suspense (12) months without having to reapply for CAPI.
