B R V C	urpose The purpose of this CIT is to notify the CalSAWS counties that the one-time list for sugust 2023 MAGI Medi-Cal Renewals impacted by the MAGI Medi-Cal Renewals CalHEERS issue for CA 262142 is posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal. Cackground Outlinely, when the MAGI Medi-Cal RE batch is processed by CalHEERS, individuals who are already active on MAGI Medi-Cal are processed as 'discontinued' as appropriate. Our the June, July, and August 2023 Renewals, SAWS and CalHEERS have identified CalHEERS system issue related to the processing of the MAGI Medi-Cal Renewals. CalHEERS is returning the eligibility result of 'Ineligible' for the MAGI Members who are currently 'Active' in SAWS in certain circumstances. CalHEERS should determine MAGI Medi-Cal members who are no longer eligible to MAGI as 'Discontinued' or Soft Pause.' The incorrect 'Ineligible' status could prevent a MAGI Medi-Cal Member from:
	 Moving into Soft Pause (which allows the screening of consumer protection programs and Non-MAGI Medi-Cal programs) Generating the correct Notices of Action Transitioning to Covered California (with and without financial assistance)

4. This system issue may also impact the automated batch discontinuances when a MAGI Medi-Cal member fails to complete the renewal.

Correct MAGI Medi-Cal eligibility determinations are imperative, to ensure beneficiaries receive the correct benefits. The DHCS provided guidance for the impacted population, is <u>counties must delay processing the impacted June, July, and August 2023 annual renewals</u> until this system issue is resolved.

System validations are on the MAGI Determination List page, the Run EDBC and the Negative Action pages for this current MAGI Medi-Cal Renewal Batch issue. Additionally, the Batch MAGI and Batch EDBC skips these Medi-Cal cases that appear on the posted list. The MAGI Medi-Cal Renewals impacted by the MAGI Medi-Cal Renewals CalHEERS issue are also stored in the CalSAWS CH_Protect table.
