Background Due to the Public Health Emergency (PHE), counties have not been required to process Medi-Cal renewals since the year 2020. Per MEDIL 1 23-02 issued by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) on January 10, 2023, federal legislation provided an end date to the continuous coverage requirement enacted as a result of the PHE. Effective April 1, 2023, counties resumed renewal activities beginning with beneficiaries with June 2023 renewal dates.
