3.1 Highlights of the Reporting Period – Performance Test

The BenefitsCal performance team successfully executed two (2) rounds of 100% volume isolated performance test with 47 scripts, covering major business functions. These tests were executed with BenefitsCal mock services. In the first test, less user load in the document upload scripts was executed which resulted in lower business metrics achieved, however, overall metrics including average response time and errors were comparable to the baseline test result. In the second test, the team observed partner document upload API gateway timeouts, causing spike to the average response time and error count. However, the overall BenefitsCal performance in terms of the average response time and errors was comparable to the November monthly release mock services baseline test results. The detailed Jmeter reports, and the results summary/comparison report is uploaded to CalSAWS SharePoint.

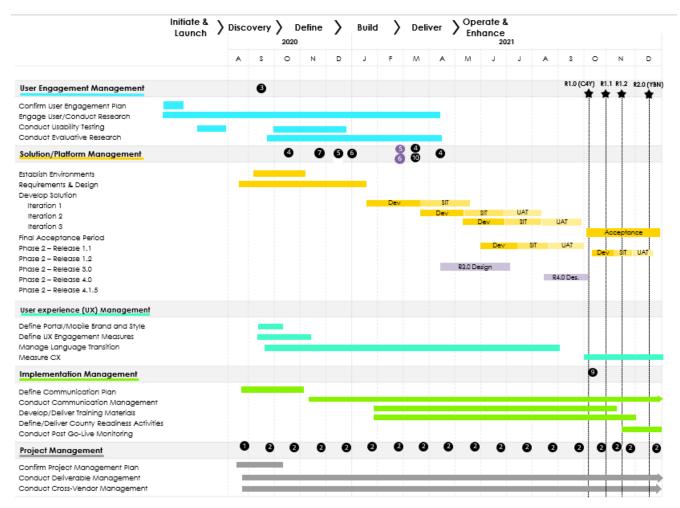


