





Are you tired of always searching for the same items in the LMS? Did you know you can **Save** content for quick access? On any item in the LMS there is a **Save** button, click on it and now that item will appear on your Saved Content page.




To access the Saved Content page, click on the down caret on the toolbar and select Saved Content.

When you open a document in the LMS click the **Save** icon on the top right of the document. This allows you to keep a frequently used document readily available.



CalSAWS Pages


- Images buttons within CalSAWS
 - Most pages in CalSAWS have an Images button at the top.
 - The Case Summary > Images button displays all images captured within the last 365 days.
 - Other Images buttons are based on the context of the page.
- Point of Service button within CalSAWS
 - The Case Summary > Point of Service button displays all BenefitsCal and CalSAWS Kiosk uploads within the last 90 days.



CalSAWS Imaging Tricks and Tips: Viewing Images

Document Viewer

- Use the Related Documents button to view up to 500 documents for the Case Number or CIN without a date restriction
 - Open any image for the needed Case Number or CIN.
 - In the top right, select the middle button.
 - Update the Relationship to "Scope Related Documents".



Wolf Wisdom: You can open multiple documents in different windows/tabs when opening from Relationship panel




Wave 6 San Luis Obispo

We get by with a little help from our friends.. Project RM's SLO, FRESNO & TULARE PPOC's







- With pep in our steps, we eagerly entered the SLO command Center expecting to find some level of angst among the Leadership only to be welcomed with smiling faces, welcome bags, badges, treats and Hawaiian leis (used to identify support on the floor). The calm and organized leadership set the tone for success, and we could see it right away.
- SLO was not only going live with a new operating system (CalSAWS) but they were piloting a call center and introducing kiosks in the lobbies for the first time. As if this wasn't enough, they also achieved a 100% completion rate on their web-based trainings (WBT'S). This allowed the staff a sense of confidence as they utilized the on-site support staff and virtual assistants to supplement their learning process.
- In addition to the positive responsiveness to questions and resources the county leadership embraced the staff by hosting certain days of Go Live by dressing up for Halloween to dressing in Hawaiian style. The Regional Managers not only participated in the activities, but they also facilitated the county comradery by having the PPOC's from Fresno and Tulare join the PPOC and RM's in the command center of San Luis Obispo.
