Description:	<p>Purpose The purpose of this CIT is to inform CalSAWS counties of posted lists associated with SCR CA-278483 – Extension of Eligibility for Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolee- List of Impacted Cases</p> <p>Background ACWDL XX-24 identifies the following categories of individuals arriving from Ukraine as eligible for Office of Refugee Resettlement (ORR) and other federal benefits available for refugees:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A. Citizens or nationals of Ukraine who the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has paroled into the U.S. between February 24, 2022, and September 30, 2024 (extended from the original end date of September 30, 2023), due to urgent humanitarian reasons or for significant public benefit, known as Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees (UHPs).</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">B. Non-Ukrainian individuals who last habitually resided in Ukraine and who DHS has paroled into the U.S. between February 24, 2022, and September 30, 2024 (extended from the original end date of</p>

	<p>September 30, 2023), due to urgent humanitarian reasons or for significant public benefit.</p> <p>C. A spouse or child, as defined in section 101(b) of the INA (8 U.S.C. § 1101(b)), of an individual described in section A. or B. who is paroled into the U.S. after September 30, 2023.</p> <p>D. A parent, legal guardian, or primary caregiver of an unaccompanied refugee minor or an unaccompanied child described in section A. or B. who is paroled into the U.S. after September 30, 2023. An unaccompanied child is defined within 6 U.S.C. § 279(g)(2).</p> <p>Additional Information For eligible Ukrainian parolees who entered the United States with parole between February 24, 2022 – Sept 30, 2023, their date of eligibility is May 21, 2022, or their date of parole, whichever is later.</p> <p>For eligible Ukrainian parolees who enter the United States with parole between October 1, 2023 – Sept 30, 2024, their date of eligibility is April 24, 2024, or their date of parole, whichever is later.</p> <p>County Action The list of cases has been posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal in following location: <div style="background-color: black; height: 20px; width: 100%;"></div></p> <p>Counties must follow the steps below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Review all denied, discontinue, pending or ineligible applications that were submitted by potentially eligible UHPs on or after April 24, 2024. Determine if the applicant is eligible to additional benefits by using the criteria listed in ACWDL XX-24. If so, counties will retroactively approve benefits based on the date of application. Run EDBC and complete an override for the programs that are eligible for additional benefits. Journal all actions according to your county's policy. <p>Note: The workers may utilize the ACWDL XX-24 for guidance until the implementation of SCR CA-278104 that is tentatively scheduled for 24.09.</p> <p>If you have questions on this CIT, please reach out to the Primary Contact and cc your Regional Managers.</p>
