- Tentative release date for the project would be May 2025.
- Data will have its own database (RDS Amazon Aurora)
- Impacts will be on Cash Aid Time Limit pages (not GR), TOA batch jobs, TOA correspondence, One-time WDTIP data migration, EDD partner application, Analytics/Reports, Adhoc Reporting (EDR/APEX), BenefitsCal, and Training materials (WBT/Job Aids/Online help)
- Progress updates will be provided in future Time Limits Committee meetings.

SCR CA-277623 Restrict 380 PFL Exemption to CalWORKs

- Will the addition of Immediate Need be analyzed for associated Batch jobs prior to implementation? It will be reviewed but hasn't yet.
- o Income record does not need to exist if exemption is manually added.
- Batch applies exemption only for future month(s). Retro months will be covered in another SCR in the future. SCR number is unknown.

Open Topics:

- Was issue that THA TANF is ticking in CalSAWS but doesnt in MEDs fixed?
 - CA-264987 "Correct Homeless Mapping for TANF Clock" still in TBD status
- Unable to reconcile time limit records (Tulare)
 - Most are in resolved stats with two defects (CA-278359 = UEID when select exemption 316 and CA-278868 = Extender 605 is unable to be selected).
 Both Defects will be in release 24.07
- Update to Aid code 35.
 - CDSS is going take it back, coordinate a response and something in an email
- It was stated that CDSS is moving forward with creating a new Aid Code for two person AU, one timed out, is that accurate?
 - CDSS CalWORKs Policy Response: that is correct. A new aid code of 2P for AUs where one parent is timed out. DSS has drafted an aid code description to share/discuss at the next CAT meeting in early August.
- Counties request method to share incident information concerning TOA
 - Possibility of adding an excelsheet in the Time Limits Committee folder that counties can use to track TOA specific issues & Incident numbers, will be reviewed (13 counties gave a thumbs up)
 - Possibility of incidents being reviewed by counties within Regions and then added as an agenda item when found to be impactful (3 counties voted for this option)
