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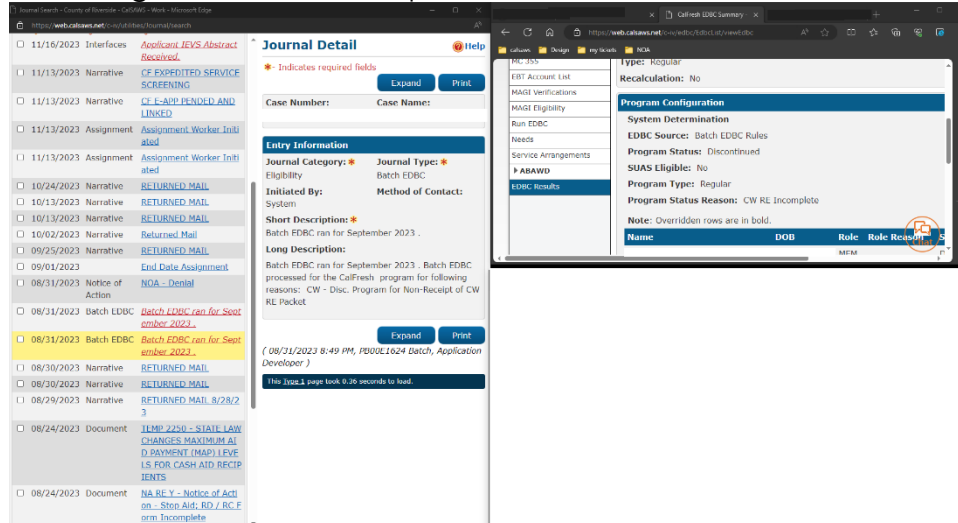
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1 OVERVIEW

1. Remove "CW" from the display text of the status reason that is set when a program is discontinued due to an incomplete or not received packet.
2. This effort will be to update the logic that currently sends out Discontinuance NOAs to no longer generate a CF 377.4 SAR (06/13) NOA when there is a SAR 7 that is at "Sent", "Received" or "Incomplete" status and the NA 960 X/Y has been sent.
3. Align the journal and EDBC failure reason to match when a program fails for a missing or incomplete RE. The text of the status reason when a program fails for a missing or incomplete RE should not include "CW".

1.1 Current Design

1. Currently when EDBC fails for "CW RE Incomplete" the journal entry will state "Batch EDBC processed for CalFresh program for the following reasons: CW – Disc. Program for Non-Receipt of CW RE Packet."



2. Currently CF 377.4 SAR (06/13) is generating when SAR 7 and NA 960 X/Y is sent.
3. Currently when a program is discontinued for an incomplete or not received packet, the discontinuance status reason description includes "CW" (i.e., "CW RE Incomplete" or "CW RE Not Received") even if the program is not "CW".

1.2 Requests

1. Remove "CW" from the display text of the status reason that is set when a program is discontinued due to an incomplete or not received packet.
2. Update the logic that currently sends out Discontinuance NOAs to no longer generate a CF 377.4 SAR (06/13) NOA when there is a SAR 7 that is at "Sent", "Received" or "Incomplete" status and the NA 960 X/Y has been sent.
3. Update the journal and EDBC failure reason to match when failed at RE. The text of the status reason when a program fails for a missing or incomplete RE should not include "CW".

1.3 Overview of Recommendations

1. Remove "CW" from the status reasons "CW RE Incomplete" and "CW RE Not Received" that are set when a program is discontinued due to an incomplete or not received packet.
2. Update the logic that currently sends out Discontinuance NOAs to no longer generate a CF 377.4 SAR (06/13) NOA when there is a SAR 7 that is at "Sent", "Received" or "Incomplete" status and the NA 960 X/Y has been sent.
3. When EDBC fails for an incomplete packet, update the journal entry reason to state incomplete rather than non-received. This is applicable to CalWORKs and CalFresh.

1.4 Assumptions

1. There are no other changes to the form's generation conditions or variable population logic, unless otherwise stated in this design document.
2. Currently PB00E141 CW RE Discontinuance job discontinue CW/CF program when the CW RE packet / CW/CF combo packet is in Review Ready to Run EDBC status. PB00E141 will discontinue CW/CF case if the status is anything but 'Complete'/'Not Applicable'.
3. PB00E139 CalFresh (CF) RE Discontinuance job discontinue CF program when the RE due is not advance.
4. Removing "CW" from the status reason text will only affect how it displays online in the system. It will not change any other functionality related to that status in CalSAWS.
When this SCR is implemented, the "CW" will be removed from all existing instances of the two affected status reasons, as well as from all new ones that are created after this SCR is implemented. This change will not affect the text of existing journal entries created prior to the implementation of this SCR.
5. The SCR CA-280104 will handle the SAR 7 "Received" suppression logic.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Eligibility: Update Discontinuance Reason Display Text

2.1.1 Overview

Update the status reason description for a missing or incomplete RE to no longer include "CW". This update will be made on the existing rows in the code table so that it will apply when viewing any existing occurrences of those statuses in CalSAWS, as well as when viewing new statuses created after this SCR is implemented.

1. For all occurrences of these two status reasons in the code table (i.e. expired ones with an end date in the past as well as high-dated ones):

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1 OVERVIEW

SCH_NACT (variable 38) identifies individuals who were or were not scheduled for their next activity within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion (i.e., the first approved activity scheduled after OCAT/Appraisal completion). SCH_NACT is the numerator of the OCAT/Appraisal to next activity timeliness rate.

1.1 Current Design

The logic to populate SCH_NACT (variable 38) in Cal-OAR 19A looks for an activity where the Created date is populated within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion date.

1.2 Requests

Update the logic of SCH_NACT in Cal-OAR 19A.

1.3 Overview of Recommendations

1. Update the criteria of SCH_NACT to the following:
 1. Status of next Activity is 'Active', 'Closed', or 'Completed'.
 - a. To order activities from most recent to least recent, activities are first sorted by the scheduled start date of the activity (in descending order), then by activity status, with 'Active' first, then 'Completed', then 'Closed'.
 - b. The "next Activity" cannot be another OCAT/Appraisal activity.
 1. There exists a "next" activity with a created date of the next Activity is populated on the same day as or within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion date.
 - a. "Created date" refers to the date the activity was created.
 - b. "OCAT/Appraisal completion date" refers to the activity status begin date of the 'Completed' status on an OCAT/Appraisal Activity. An OCAT/Appraisal activity is an activity of Type = 'Appraisal' or 'Orientation/Appraisal'.
 - c. For a given activity status begin date of the 'Completed' status on an OCAT/Appraisal activity, the created date of the next activity must be the same day or within 30 days for this measure to return 02.
 - d. If there are multiple OCAT/Appraisal completion dates within a measurement month, this measure can return 02 as long as at least one of them has a next activity with a created date on the same day as or within 30 days.
 2. The "next" activity is not an activity of Type = 'Appraisal', 'Orientation', or 'Orientation/Appraisal'.
3. Individual has a WTW/REP program in the measurement month.

1.4 Assumptions

1. All existing functionalities will remain unchanged unless called out as part of this SCR.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 Update criteria of SCH_NACT in Cal-OAR 19A

2.1.1 Overview

SCH_NACT variable will be updated based on the criteria in section 2.1.2.

2.1.2 Description of Change

1. Modify the logic of SCH_NACT to the following:
 1. Status of next Activity is 'Active', 'Closed', or 'Completed'.
 - a. To order activities from most recent to least recent, activities are first sorted by the scheduled start date of the activity (in descending order), then by activity status, with 'Active' first, then 'Completed', then 'Closed'.
 - b. The "next Activity" cannot be another OCAT/Appraisal activity.
 1. There exists a "next" activity with a created date of the next Activity is populated on the same day as or within 30 days of an OCAT/Appraisal completion date.
 - a. "Created date" refers to the date the activity was created.
 - b. "OCAT/Appraisal completion date" refers to the activity status begin date of the 'Completed' status on an OCAT/Appraisal Activity. An OCAT/Appraisal activity is an activity of Type = 'Appraisal' or 'Orientation/Appraisal'.
 - c. For a given activity status begin date of the 'Completed' status on an OCAT/Appraisal activity, the created date of the next activity must be the same day or within 30 days for this measure to return 02.
 - d. If there are multiple OCAT/Appraisal completion dates within a measurement month, this measure can return 02 as long as at least one of them has a next activity with a created date on the same day as or within 30 days.
 2. The "next" activity is not an activity of Type = 'Appraisal', 'Orientation', or 'Orientation/Appraisal'.
3. Individual has a WTW/REP program in the measurement month.

Response options:

01 = Individual has a WTW/REP program in the measurement month but does not meet rest of the criteria.

02 = Meets all criteria.

99 = Individual does not have a WTW/REP program in the measurement month.

Example 1:

Appraisal activity with scheduled start date 11/25/2023 and scheduled end date 11/25/2023. 'Active – Referred' status with begin date of 11/9/2023 and end date of 11/24/2023. The status of 'Completed – Completed Satisfactory' has a begin date of 11/25/2023.

There is no activity ~~scheduled after~~ created after 11/25/2023.

Outcome: ~~The expected comparison is between the completed Appraisal activity start date and the created date of the next activity.~~ Since there is no ~~next~~ activity created after the OCAT/Appraisal activity 'Completed' status begin date of 11/25/2023, SCH_NACT should return 01 for the report month of November 2023.

Example 2:

Appraisal activity was created on 11/15/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/16/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/16/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/19/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/17/2023.

Employment activity was created on 11/20/2023 with a scheduled activity begin date of 11/21/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/22/2024.

Outcome: ~~The expected comparison is between the 'Completed' activity status begin date of 11/17/2023 for the Appraisal activity and the created date of 11/20/2023 for the Employment activity.~~ There exists an activity created within 30 days of the OCAT/Appraisal activity 'Completed' status begin date of 11/17/2023, which is the Employment activity that was created on 11/20/2023. Since the Employment activity is not another OCAT/Appraisal activity, SCH_NACT should return 02 for the report month of November 2023.

Example 3:

Appraisal activity was created on 11/15/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/16/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/16/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/19/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/17/2023.

Appraisal activity was created on 11/20/2023 with a scheduled activity begin date of 11/21/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/22/2024.

Outcome: There exists an activity created within 30 days of the OCAT/Appraisal activity 'Completed' status begin date of 11/17/2023, which is the Appraisal activity that was created on 11/20/2023. Since the "next activity" cannot be another OCAT/Appraisal activity and there is no

other activity created on the same day as or within 30 days of 11/17/2023, SCH_NACT should return 01 for the report month of November 2023.

Example 4:

Appraisal activity was created on 11/15/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/16/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/16/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/19/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/17/2023.

For the same individual, there is another Appraisal activity that was created on 11/22/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/23/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/23/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/25/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/24/2023.

Employment activity was created on 11/26/2023 with a scheduled activity begin date of 11/27/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/28/2024.

Outcome: For the first Appraisal activity, there is no valid "next activity". For the second Appraisal activity, the expected comparison is between the 'Completed' activity status begin date of 11/24/2023 for the Appraisal activity and the created date of 11/26/2023 for the Employment activity. Since there are two Appraisal activities with a 'Completed' status begin date within the measurement month of November 2023, both 11/17/2023 and 11/24/2023 can be used to check whether there exists an activity created on or within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion. The Employment activity was created on 11/26/2023, which is within 30 days of both 11/17/2023 and 11/24/2023, SCH_NACT should return 02 for the report month of November 2023.

Example 5:

Appraisal activity was created on 11/15/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/16/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/16/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/19/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/17/2023.

Employment activity was created on 11/18/2023 with a scheduled activity begin date of 11/18/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/28/2024.

For the same individual, there is another Appraisal activity that was created on 11/22/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/23/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/23/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/25/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/24/2023.

Outcome: Since there are two Appraisal activities with a 'Completed' status begin date within the measurement month of November 2023, both 11/17/2023 and 11/24/2023 can be used to check whether there exists an activity created on or within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion. The

Employment activity was created on 11/18/2023, which is within 30 days of 11/17/2023, but not 11/24/2023. SCH_NACT should return 02 for the report month of November 2023.

Example 6:

Appraisal activity was created on 11/15/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/16/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/16/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/19/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/17/2023.

Employment activity was created on 11/18/2023 with a scheduled activity begin date of 11/18/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/28/2024.

For the same individual, there is another Appraisal activity that was created on 11/22/2023 with scheduled activity begin date of 11/23/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/23/2023. 'Completed' status was created on 11/25/2023 with activity status begin date of 11/24/2023.

Employment activity was created on 1/1/2024 with a scheduled activity begin date of 11/18/2023 and scheduled activity end date of 11/28/2024.

Outcome: Since there are two Appraisal activities with a 'Completed' status begin date within the measurement month of November 2023, both 11/17/2023 and 11/24/2023 can be used to check whether there exists an activity created on or within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion. The first Employment activity was created on 11/18/2023, which is within 30 days of 11/17/2023, but not 11/24/2023. The second Employment activity was created on 1/1/2024, which is not within 30 days of either 11/17/2023 or 11/24/2023. Since there is one activity created on or within 30 days of OCAT/Appraisal completion, SCH_NACT should return 02 for the report month of November 2023.
