### Justification / Request Summary:

Update Social Security income types

## Issue:

CalSAWS does not mirror Social Security Income Types when the Income Category is Social Security. This leads to eligibility problems for CFET Work Registration.

Social Security provides the following Income Types:

- Retirement
- Disability
- Spouse's/Dependent Children
- Survivors

CalSAWS only allows for the following Social Security Income Types:

- Retirement
- Disability
- Survivors

When the income received is from 'Spouse's/Dependent Children' (income based off a spouse, parent's or child's disability) there is no equivalent entry in CalSAWS.

Because the Income Type drives the CFET Work Registration:

We are unable to use Social Security- Disability for the non-disabled spouse because it will cause the CFWR to reflect Exempt due to disability.

We also cannot use the income Type: Social Security Retirement or Social Security Survivors because this is not a true representation of the income that is received.

#### Proposed Recommendation:

When the Income Category is Social Security, and the Type is Social Security Disability, add an additional social security income Drop down option 'Received By' to indicate if the income is received for the Disabled Individual or for the Spouse/Dependent Child(ren) of the Disabled Individual.

- 1. If the income is received by the individual, then the Work Registration will map as Exempt.
- 2. If the income is received by the Spouse, then the Work Registration will map as Mandatory.
- 3. If the income is received by the Dependent Child, then the Work Registration will map as
  - a. Exempt if under 16
  - b. Exempt if 16-17 and attending school
  - c. Mandatory if over 16 and not found Exempt
