Purpose (Identify what Counties this CIT affects)

The purpose of this CIT is to inform counties of the alternate process to pay Dual Agency Rates for Dual Agency children placed in a Foster Family Agency setting.

Currently, CalSAWS does not have Dual Agency RC-California Early Start Intervention (P1) or Dual Agency RC-Lanterman Developmental Disability (P2) on the drop-down choices on the Foster Care "Rate Detail" page when selecting Foster Family Agency Certified Resource Family Home (FFACRFH) as a Placement Type on the Foster Care "Child Placement Detail" page.

With SCR CA-277036 slated for Release 24.11, counties can follow these steps as a temporary alternative process to pay the (P1) & (P2) rates.

Background

ACL 24-04 now clarifies eligibility to children/Non-Minor Dependents (NMD's) placed with Foster Family Agency Resource Family Homes for the Dual Agency Rate.

County Action

Follow steps to pay the (P1) & (P2) Dual Agency Rates

On the Foster Care "<u>Child Placement Detail</u>" page, after selecting the appropriate Placement Name, Placement type, and completing all mandatory fields:

	 Click Add in the Rate List section, select Non-Standard Rate from "Type" dropdown list, and enter appropriate dollar amount in the Rate field. Select monthly as the frequency and enter the Begin date of the rate Save and Return and Save the page. Run EDBC, Authorize, and Add a Journal Entry to identify actions taken.
