Memorandum Purpose:

This memorandum is intended to convey the batch EDBC scope, county actions and schedule for the referenced program changes.

Scope:

Per ACL 24-XX, SCR CA-257180 will implement the CalWORKs Tier 1 and Tier 2 IRT increase rates on 09/05/2024.

Per ACL 24-55, SCR CA-257180 will implement the CalWORKs MAP increase rates on 09/05/2024.

Per ACIN I-XX-24 and Nutrition Service SNAP COLA Memo FY 2025, SCR CA-257180 will implement the CalFresh COLA increase rates on 09/05/2024.

To minimize the work required by the counties, the project will begin running EDBCs on 09/07/2024. The EDBCs and NOAs are expected to run from 9/07/2024 - 09/10/2024.

<u>CalWORKs MAP, Tier1 and Tier 2 IRT, CalFresh COLA Batch EDBC Processing will start on 09/07/2024 with SCR CA-257179:</u>

1. Batch:

- a. Run batch EDBC beginning 09/07/2024 for the benefit month of 10/2024 including past RE due date cases for:
 - i. All cases with an active or ineligible Foster Care program with ARC aid codes 2T, 2S, or 2U effective for 10/2024 in single program mode. Exclude the following cases:
 - 1. EDBC will not be triggered on programs with a Nonstandard rate in effect in the benefit month.
 - EDBC will not run if a regular EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-257180 went into production.
 - 3. EDBC will not run for 'Yellow Banner' programs. NOTE: Counties can check 'Yellow Banner' programs daily with the latest Qlik report.
 - Run the above population with Run Reason 'CW/CF COLA' (CT744_CF).

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- iii. Run the above population with Sub Type code 'CW/CF COLA' (CT942_C1)
- b. Run batch EDBC beginning 09/07/2024 for the benefit month of 10/2024 for:
 - All cases with an active or ineligible CalWORKs or RCA program in targeted program mode. Targeting program mode will include CF and NB programs on the CW/CF combo cases.

Exclude the following cases:

- 1. The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the program.
- 2. The program has a SAR7 Due Month of 09/2024, and the report status is Generated, Sent, Received, or Incomplete.
- 3. A regular EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-257180 went to production.
- EDBC will not run for 'Yellow Banner' programs. NOTE: Counties can check 'Yellow Banner' programs daily with the latest Qlik report.
- ii. Run the above population with Run Reason 'CW/CF COLA' (CT744_CF).
- iii. Run the above population with Sub Type code 'CW/CF COLA' (CT942_C1)

NOTE: Batch shall process recommendation b. only after the completion of recommendation a. This is to ensure that active Foster Care programs are accurately updated prior to the processing of CalFresh program.

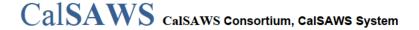
- c. Run batch EDBC beginning 9/07/2024 for the benefit month of 10/2024 for:
 - All active or ineligible CF (including TCF) programs in targeted program mode and include NB program.

Exclude the following cases:

- 1. The benefit month is past the latest RE due date for the program.
- 2. The program has a SAR7 Due Month of 09/2024, and the report status is Generated, Sent, Received, or Incomplete.
- 3. EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since SCR CA-257180 went to production.
- EDBC will not run for 'Yellow Banner' programs. NOTE: Counties can check 'Yellow Banner' programs daily with the latest Qlik report.
- ii. Run the above population with run reason 'CF COLA' (CT744_FS).
- iii. Run the above population with Sub Type code 'CF COLA' (CT942_C3).

NOTE: Batch shall process recommendation c. only after the completion of recommendation b. This is to ensure that an active CalFresh program with household members active on a different CalWORKs case gets processed accurately.

The SAR 2 will be generating via EDBC and an operational DCR will be implemented to prevent multiple SAR2s from generating per single case with this COLA run.

TEMP 2250 will be mass mailed with the SCR CA-281371 targeted for 09/12/2024.

Notices will be generated with each County EDBC population and sent to the Central Printing facility at the time the County EDBCs and NOAs are completed/generated (09/07/2024-09/10/2024).

3. Journal:

A journal entry will be created for each program run by the batch EDBC process. This will be the standard journal entry added by the batch EDBC process. The long description will read:

- a. Foster Care EDBCs run with Sub Type code 'CW/CF COLA':
 "Batch EDBC ran for <month, year>. Batch EDBC Ran for <Effective Month>.
 Batch EDBC processed for the program for following reasons: CW/CF COLA."

Development Schedule

- 1. Deliver the FC/CW/CF driving query and list queries to the System Test team on 08/22/2024.
- 2. System Testing of the FC/CW/CF batch process will occur between 08/22/2024 and 09/06/2024.
- 3. FC/CW/CF batch EDBC processing will begin in production on 09/07/2024.

Things to remember about these batch EDBC processes:

- All impacts from Defects and SCRs which have not been implemented will continue to occur during the batch processing.
- There are multiple reasons why a program may not be successfully run through batch EDBC processing. Some examples include: No Worker Assigned, Overridden Program Case, and Pending Program/Person/Application. Please review tasks and the Batch Eligibility Report daily.
- The EDBCs will have an EDBC Source of 'Batch EDBC Rules'.

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- When a user runs EDBC on a case where a prior pending month exists, the EDBC will
 have a type of Read-Only. When running Batch EDBC that restriction does not apply
 and these EDBCs will not be Read-Only.
- Any updates or lack of updates made/not made to cases will impact the Batch EDBC results. This means programs may be discontinued (due to non-compliances, etc.) unexpectedly.

County Action:

- Review cases included in the lists and take necessary action.
- Review the Batch Eligibility Report and action cases which could not be processed. This
 report is an on-request report available under Global: Reports > Local: On Request >
 Task: Administrative. If you do not see this report, please contact your Security
 Administrator for rights. To see cases not processed select a status of 'Not Processed' on
 the Reports Parameters pages.
- Counties can check 'yellow banner' programs daily with the latest Qlik report.

Schedule Considerations:

- CalSAWS will not be down when the batch processing begins on Saturday, September 07, 2024.
- There will be no interruption to the regularly scheduled batch jobs during the COLA batch processing.
- Approximately 3.1 + million active programs will be processed during the FC/CW/CF batch EDBC process in CalSAWS for the benefit month of 10/2024.
- Approximately 50,000 programs processed per hour via batch EDBC.

Timeline:

 FC/CW/CF Batch EDBC processing and NOA generation will begin on 09/07/2024 and continue thru 09/10/2024.
