Current Design: When a Medi-Cal program is reapplied, or a new application is logged, and the Application Date is in the past, the RE Due Date is established as Application Date + 11 months. When the Application Date is set to a date in the past, the RE Due Date will be set per the back-dated Application Date and may calculate to a date in the past upon approval.

There are exceptions to using the Application Date such as with 1.) Former Foster Youth where the RE Due Date is based on the applicant's 26th birthday and 2.) Auto-Test from Discontinuance where the RE Due Date is maintained per the Discontinued program.

Request: Per DHCS confirmation and ACWDL 06-16, RE Due Date to be set to the Beginning Date of Aid (BDA) + 11 months for new Medi-Cal applications

Recommendation: 1. Update the Medi-Cal RE Due Date calculation to now use BDA + 11 months instead of Application Date + 11 months.

Note: Scenarios where the RE Due Date is not based on the Application Date will not be impacted by this change and will continue to follow existing logic.

Assumption: No Client Correspondence changes are required with this change as Client Correspondence team has confirmed they do not perform their own RE Due Date calculation for Medi-Cal NOAs.
