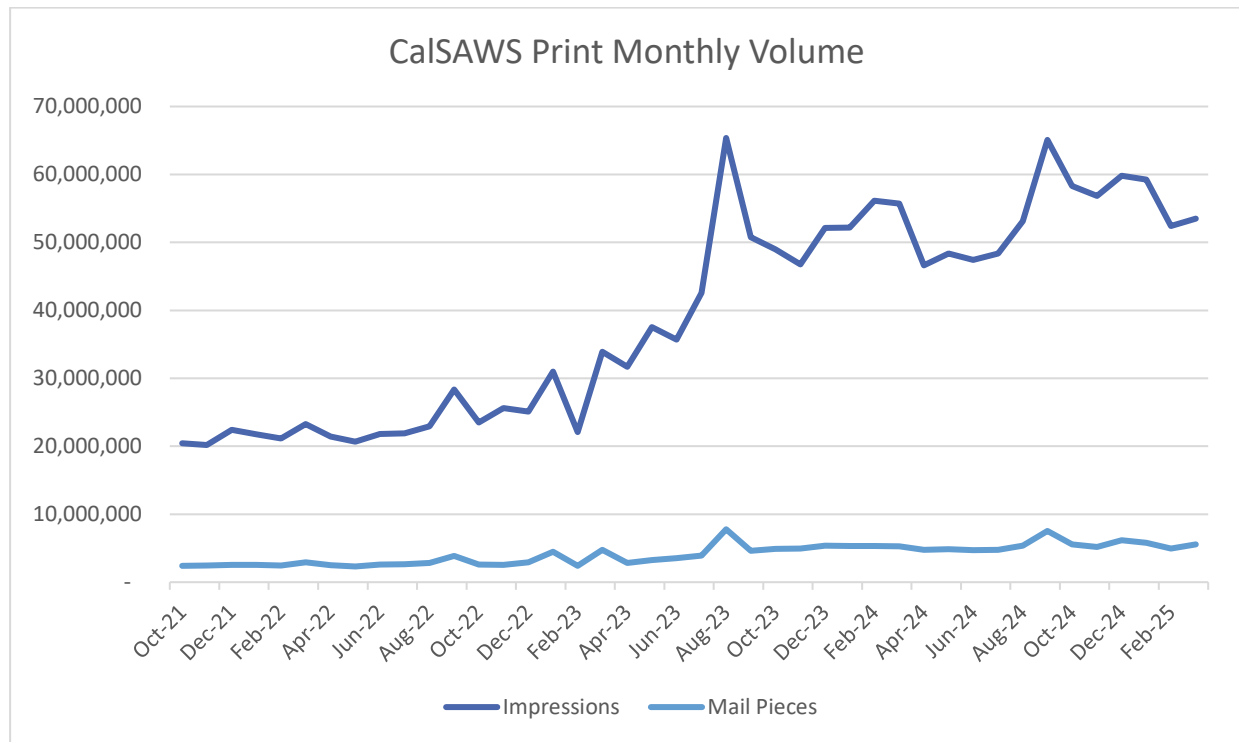


Figure 1: Monthly Print and Mail Volume
