CA-290537 – Add California Residency Verification

1 OVERVIEW

In alignment with CalHEERS CR 304049, a new process will be implemented to place members in conditional eligibility instead of being eligible for full-scope MAGI Medi-Cal benefits when MEDS or Franchise Tax Board (FTB) is unable to electronically verify California residency during the intake application process. This new process will prevent erroneous coverage from being granted to members who have not verified their California residency.

1.1 Current Design

CalHEERS currently checks California residency by verifying residency data against information received from MEDS and Franchise Tax Board (FTB). When MEDS or FTB are unable to verify California residency, CalHEERS will send a verification status for pending residency in the DER/DER-U as "Residency" to display on the below screens.

- MAGI Determination Summary
- MAGI Determination Detail
- MAGI Referral Detail

Eligibility continues to be granted despite the residency status remaining unverified.

1.2 Requests

As part of release 26.2 CalHEERS CR 304049, a new Eligibility Evaluation Reason Code (EERC) "RD" will be introduced for Non-Primary Applicants who have their Residency Verification derived from a Primary Applicant if they meet the below criteria:

- 1. California residency is unable to be electronically or administratively verified for a Non-Primary Applicant, and both of the following are met:
 - a. The Primary Applicant is electronically or administratively verified for CA Residency, AND
 - b. The Non-Primary Applicant lives with the Primary Applicant based on the address provided

Note: The Non-Primary Applicant also includes children (under 21 years), but the child must reside with a Primary Applicant or a parent/guardian/caretaker relative who is electronically or administratively verified.

The Eligibility Evaluation Reason Code (EERC) "RS" will be used with an updated decode when a member's California Residency Verification is "Pending" or "Not Verified".

Note: The Eligibility Evaluation Reason Code (EERC) "RS" is an existing code.

1.4 Assumptions

- 1. As part of CalHEERS CR 304049, when a Non-Primary Applicant assumes a derived verification status, both the verification status and the verification source will be the same as the Primary Applicant if all criteria are met (see section 1.2).
 - a. **Example:** Primary Applicant is e-verified through FTB, so both Primary Applicant and Spouse are e-verified with FTB as the verification source.
- 2. As part of CalHEERS CR 304049, a Non-Primary Applicant (Adult or Child) who has a derived verification status is not given the verification status directly from the hub. It is copied over from the Primary Applicant by CalHEERS and sent to CalSAWS in the DER/DER-U for CalSAWS to store.
- 3. At intake, CalHEERS will determine MAGI Conditionally Eligible with Primary Aid Code 8E (Accelerated Enrollment) for adults if residency verification is pending and they are otherwise MAGI eligible.
- 4. CalHEERS will continue to determine children Conditionally Eligible with a full scope MAGI aid code and Eligibility Status Protection if residency verification is pending.
- 5. The new decode for "RS" description will be displayed for all future cases.
- 6. All existing functionalities will remain unchanged unless called out as part of the design.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

Once CalHEERS initiates the Business Rules Engine (BRE) and determines a member to be Conditionally Eligible for MAGI Medi-Cal based on residency verification, the EERC "RS" will be received through eHIT inbound on the DER/DER-U for CalSAWS to process.

If a Non-Primary Applicant (Adult or Child) has a derived residency verification status, then a new EERC "RD" will be received through eHIT inbound on the DER/DER-U.

The EERC "RS" will be decoded as "Pending Residency Verification" and EERC "RD" will be decoded as "Residency Verification Derived" for CalSAWS to display on the below screens

- MAGI Determination Summary
- MAGI Determination Detail
- MAGI Referral Detail

2.5.1 Overview

Two Eligibility Evaluation Reason Codes (EERC) will be received through eHIT inbound transactions on the DER/DER-U for CalSAWS to process. The Residency EERC "RS" will be received from CalHEERS to inform CalSAWS anytime a member is Conditionally Eligible and pending California residency verification. The Residency EERC "RD" will be received from CalHEERS to inform CalSAWS anytime a member has a derived residency verification status.




Figure 1: Eligibility Evaluation Reason (EERC) received as "RD" in the DER/DER-U and displayed on the MAGI Determination Summary page as "Residency Verification Derived" under Eligibility Evaluation Reasons
