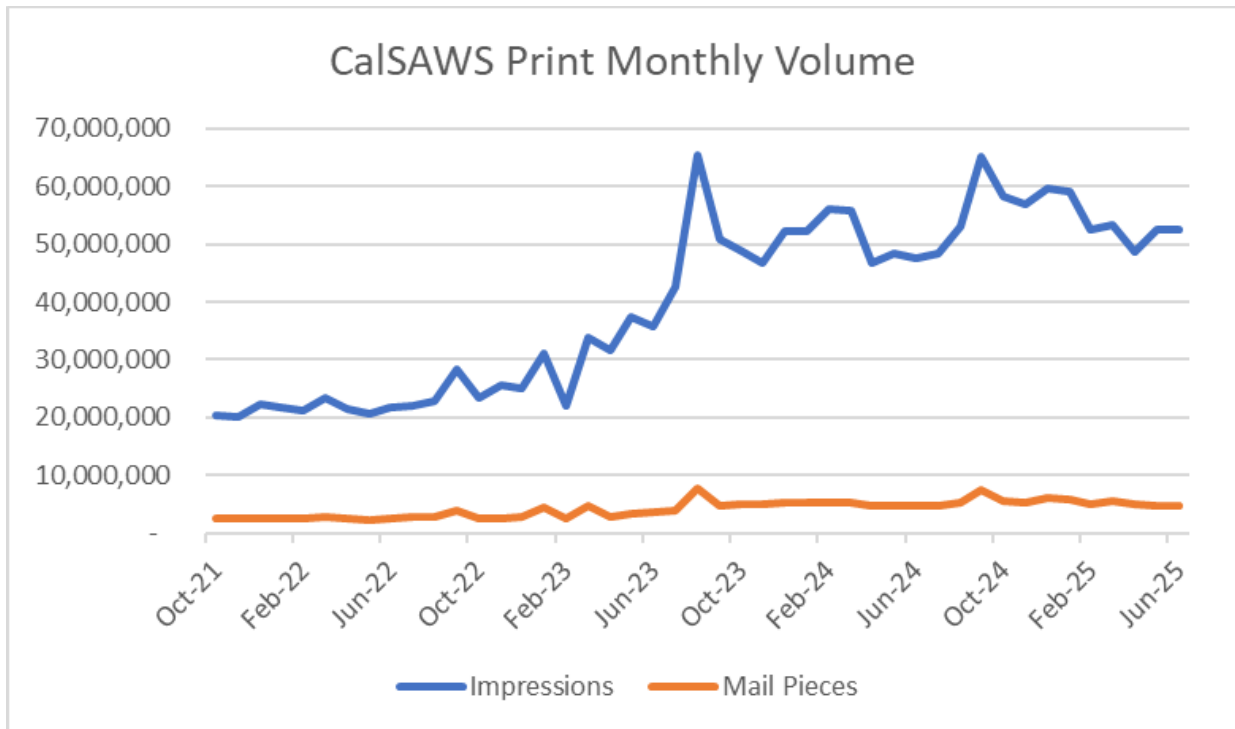


Figure 1: Monthly Print and Mail Volume

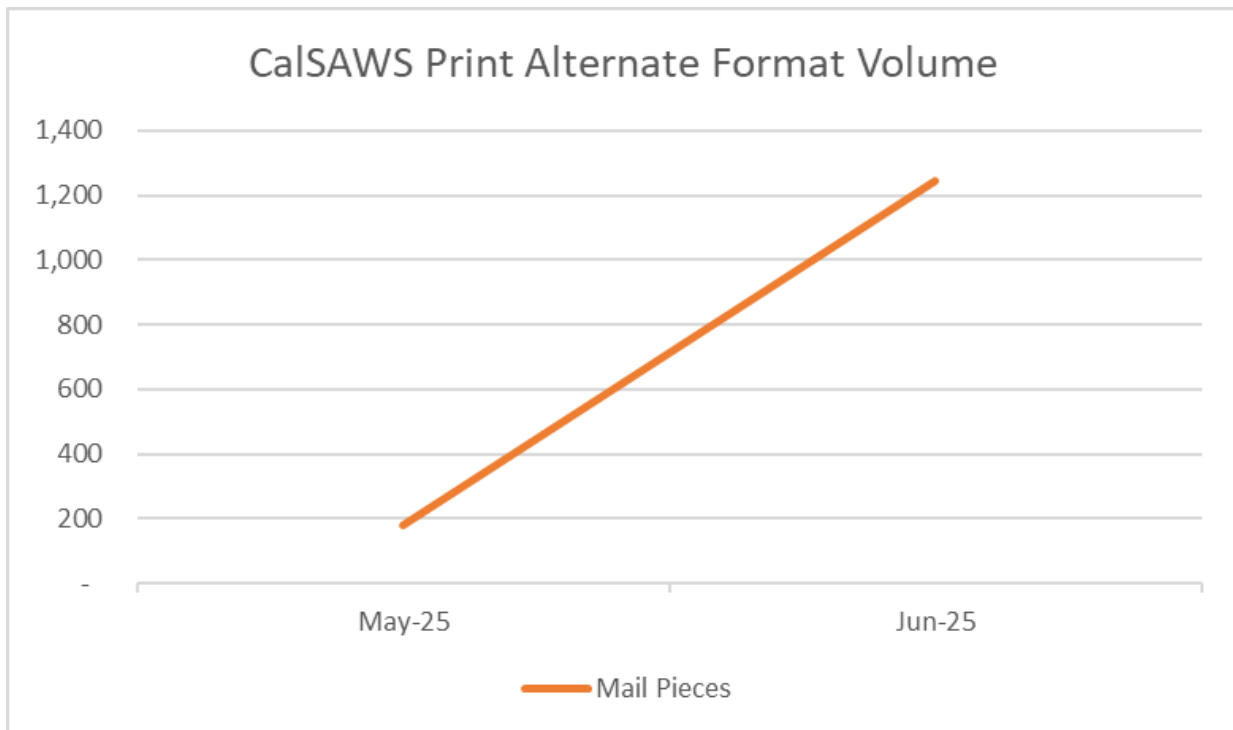


Figure 2: Monthly Alternate Format Volume
