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CA-289103 – Update RCA and TCVAP Cash Assistance Time on Aid from 12 Months to 4 Months

1 OVERVIEW

Per All County Welfare Directors Letter (ACWDL) dated May 2, 2025, time on aid for Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA) and Trafficking and Crime Victims Assistance Program (TCVAP) programs have been reduced from twelve months to four months for recipients whose eligibility date is on or after May 5, 2025. This SCR will accommodate the need to limit time on aid for RCA and TCVAP participants from 12 months to 4 months, as well as update notices for RCA and TCVAP.

1.1 Current Design

RCA and TCVAP:

CalSAWS allows RCA and TCVAP eligible households (HH) up to 12 months of benefits calculated from the date of application (state funded person) or country entry date (federally funded person).

GA/GR Automated Solution:

The individual will be eligible for GA/GR program after 12 months of RCA benefits. Once an individual has exhausted any potential eligibility to RCA, they become eligible for the GA/GR program. Currently, when determining eligibility, the system checks if the individual is receiving RCA benefits. If so, the individual is denied from the program with "Aided on Cash program" reason.

LA GR:

Similarly, the individual will be eligible for LA GR program after exhausting RCA benefits. If an individual is eligible for RCA and applies for LA GR, the individual is denied from the program with the reason "Potentially eligible for RCA".

1.2 Requests

Per ACWDL dated May 2, 2025, CalSAWS EDBC logic must be updated to allow up to 4 months of cash aid instead of existing 12 months for the RCA/TCVAP individuals with eligibility periods beginning on or after May 5, 2025. Additionally, RCA discontinuance batch sweep jobs and correspondence notices will be updated to reflect the reduction of eligibility period for RCA program from 12 months to 4 months.

1.3 Overview of Recommendations

1. Update RCA EDBC rules to close the program after 4 months of benefits for programs aided on or after May 5, 2025.
2. Update RCA Discontinuance Sweep to find cases where RCA program has reached its 4th month of eligibility instead of 12th month.
3. Update RCA Federal Discontinuance Sweep to create eligibility triggers where RCA persons have completed 4 months of eligibility instead of 12 months.
4. Update RCA State Discontinuance Sweep to create eligibility triggers where TCVAP RCA persons have completed 4 months of eligibility instead of 12 months.
5. Correspondence: Update RS 36 Form to 4 months of aid.
6. Correspondence: Update RCA Reason Fragment verbiage to reflect 4 months of aid.
 - a. RCA Approval Reason Fragment
 - b. RCA Termination Reason Fragment

1.4 Assumptions

1. TCVAP Cash Assistance benefits are issued for eligible individuals under the RCA program block using aid code "1V – RCA – TCVAP (State)".
2. No EDBC logic updates are required for LA GR and GA/GR Automated Solution Program.
3. All RCA and TCVAP Cash Assistance eligible individuals whose eligibility start date is prior to May 5, 2025, continue to be eligible for up to 12 months of RCA or TCVAP Cash Assistance benefits.
4. There are no other changes to the form's generation conditions or variable population logic, unless otherwise stated in this design document.
5. SAR7 will not be generated for cases with four-months of RCA benefits, as these cases will be discontinued before reaching the six-month period. No changes will be made to this functionality.
6. All other existing functionalities for the RCA and TCVAP programs will remain unchanged unless otherwise specified in this design document.

2.2 Update RCA EDBC Rules

2.2.1 Overview

Update RCA EDBC logic to allow up to 4 months of cash aid for individuals eligible on or after May 5, 2025.

2.2.2 Description of Changes

1. Update RCA EDBC rules to provide 4 months of benefits instead of 12 months for eligible individuals whose date of entry is on or after May 5, 2025.
2. The benefits for eligible individuals under TCVAP (provided under RCA using aid code '1V') will be 4 months instead of 12 months from the date of application.

2.2.3 Example Scenarios

Example 1: An individual applies for RCA and is determined eligible, with date of entry on May 5, 2025. Because eligibility begins on or after May 5, 2025, the system should allow up to a maximum of 4 months of RCA benefits and will be discontinued on Aug 31, 2025.

Example 2: An individual with a date of entry on March 1, 2025, applies for RCA on June 1, 2025 (BDA), and is determined eligible. Since the individual's entry date is prior to May 5, 2025, the system should provide RCA benefits for the remaining 9 months, with discontinuance on February 28, 2026.

Example 3: An individual is determined to be eligible for TCVAP with an application date of May 10, 2025. Because aid begins on or after May 5, 2025, the system should allow up to 4 months of benefits and will be discontinued on Aug 31, 2025.

Example 4: An individual with a date of entry on June 1, 2025, applies for RCA on August 1, 2025, and is determined eligible. Since the individual is eligible on or after May 5, 2025, the system should provide RCA benefits for the remaining 2 months (i.e., August and September) and discontinue the program effective September 30, 2025.

Note: The above scenarios are not requirements. They are intended to help with understanding, testing and may reference items that are not being changed by the specific language in the requirements.

2.3.1 Overview

This batch sweep will find all cases where an RCA program has reached its 4th month of eligibility instead of 12 months whose date of entry is on or after May 5, 2025.

1. Update the batch logic to trigger EDBC after the participant has been active for 4 months instead of 12 months whose date of entry is on or after May 5, 2025.
