

- State Fiscal Reports Committee. This committee is comprised of county representatives, state attendees and knowledgeable CalSAWS project staff who also attend the virtual meetings and can give and receive help via email.
 - CalSAWS Reports/Analytics Forumbee community. This resource was created for inter-county communication and knowledge sharing for the 58 counties. It is a forum site where you can post or respond to a question. The site is moderated. This community is not intended to replace the use of ServiceNow tickets. In addition to State & Fiscal Reports, users also have an Ad Hoc Forumbee 'Channel', plus 'Management and Business Intelligence' dashboards. The Reports/Analytics Forumbee officially went live on January 17th, 2025. Start using it now to ask your questions and see what helpful responses you receive! To obtain access to the Reports ForumBee 'channel', please contact your County PPOC who can contact the Regional Managers for further information.
- County Buddy Program. Access a list of County Buddies by Report type to help
