Description

Purpose

The purpose of this CIT is to provide counties with lists associated with **CA-295605 ACIN I-45-25 -2026 State Minimum Wage Run Batch EDBC**.

Background

Per All County Information Notice [ACIN I-42-25](#), the California Labor Code is increasing the minimum wage for all industries to \$16.90 per hour effective on and after January 1, 2026. This rate increase has been added in CalSAWS through SCR CA-295604 and the EDBC to apply this new rate was implemented through SCR CA-295605.

Additional Information

On December 06, 2025, Batch EDBC run for CF programs (including Transitional CalFresh) and any Nutritional Benefit programs linked to those CF programs.

Batch EDBC sweep ran on all CF cases that are active and currently receiving WINS where at least one person is considered a WEI (Work Eligible Individual) and has an income record with a work type of 'Proxy' for the benefit month of 01/2026, unless they meet the exception criteria below, and run EDBC for benefit month 01/2026 to apply the new values:

- i. Programs will not be run if the benefit month is past the latest RE due date.
- ii. Programs will not be run if there is a SAR7 Due Month of 12/2025 and the report status is Generated, Sent, Received, or Incomplete.
- iii. EDBC has already been processed for the benefit month since minimum wage rate changes went to production with SCR CA-295604 on 12/06/2025.
- iv. EDBC will not run for 'Yellow Banner' programs where the high-dated EDBC has a source of 'Conversion'. Counties can check 'Yellow Banner' programs daily with the latest Qlik report.

County Actions

The 2026 State Minimum Wage Run Batch EDBC lists have been posted to the CalSAWS Web Portal in the following location:



The lists will display the standard columns:

- Case Name
- Case Number
- County
- Unit
- Unit Name
- Office Name
- Worker ID

User's must follow their county's business process to review the cases and take any necessary actions.
